The project will consist of the following approximate items/quantities:

BASE BID – Pressure filter plant, includes a filter plant building, two 8'x20' horizontal pressure filters, plant piping, chemical feed equipment, electrical, instrumentation and controls, yard piping, and all other appurtenances designated on the plans and within the contract documents.

ADDITIVE ALTERNATE – Add a 200 KW natural gas generator, generator pad, automatic transfer switch, electrical & other appurtenances designated on the plans as a part of the alternate bid.
