The Project consists of the following: replacement of two (2) booster station pumps, cleaning and repainting booster station equipment, installation of four (4) 8" ultrasonic water meters, and addition of chemical feed equipment at water treatment plant.

Rural Water Systems Improvements Board, nor any of their employees is or will be a party to this invitation for bids or any resulting or related contracts. This procurement will be subject to all applicable sections of the Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated, as they apply to local governments, in accordance with RWAIG Program Regulations.
