For this project, bids will also be accepted through the QuestCDN online electronic bid interface. Electronic bids must be submitted through the QuestCDN online bidding interface. All electronic bids must be signed by an individual authorized to bind the Bidder. All electronic bids must be regular in every respect and no interlineations, exclusions, or special conditions shall be made or included in the Proposal by the Bidder.

An Optional Pre-Bid Conference will be held on Thursday, July 8, 2021 at 1:00PM at the Panola County Airport Terminal Building. Pre-Bid Conference attendance is optional but highly recommended for bidders on this project. Each bidder shall be limited to three personnel per organization. The project includes, but is not limited to, an asphalt mill and overlay, including grading, and marking installation on the parallel taxiway and taxiway connectors, as shown on the plans and indicated in the specifications.

Bidders must enter the addenda numbers in the Proposal to verify receipt.

Proposals shall be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check upon a national or state bank in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total maximum bid price payable without recourse to the Owner, or a bid bond in the same amount from a reliable surety company, as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into a contract and execute performance and payment bonds within ten (10) days after notice of award of Contract to him. Such bid guarantee shall be made payable to PANOLA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.

The successful bidder must furnish a performance and payment bond upon the form provided in the amount of one hundred per cent (100%) of the contract price from an approved surety company holding a permit from the State of Mississippi to act as surety, or other surety or sureties acceptable to the Owner.

All Bidders shall make good faith efforts, as defined by Appendix A of 49 CFR Part 26, Regulations of the Office of the Secretary of Transportation, to subcontract a minimum of 9.4% of the dollar value of the prime contract to small business concerns owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals (DBE).

Subject to applicable Federal law, Bidders must be qualified under Mississippi law and show a current Certificate of Responsibility issued by the Mississippi Board of Public Contractors establishing classification as to the value and type of construction work on which he/she is authorized to bid.
