Sealed bids for **FUEL FARM REHABILITATION PHASE 2 – AV GAS**, to be constructed for PANOLA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, PANOLA COUNTY AIRPORT in BATESVILLE, MISSISSIPPI, will be received at Panola County Courthouse, 151 Public Square, Batesville, MS 38606 until 1:00PM, **Thursday, December 1, 2022** at which the bids shall be publicly opened and read aloud via Microsoft Team Conference Call. The Conference Call information will be sent to plan holders upon request. Sealed bids submitted prior to the bid opening should be sent to Panola County Board of Supervisors, 151 Public Square, Batesville, MS 38606. Attn: Kate Victor-County Administrator.

For this project, bids will also be accepted through the QuestCDN online electronic bid interface. Electronic bids must be submitted through the QuestCDN online bidding interface. All electronic bids must be signed by an individual authorized to bind the Bidder. All electronic bids must be regular in every respect and no interlineations, exclusions, or special conditions shall be made or included in the Proposal by the Bidder.

The Project consists of removal of existing AV Gas tank, the construction of a concrete pad and installation of an AV Gas fuel tank, dispensing equipment, and associated electrical work, as shown on the plans and indicated in the specifications.

Bids will be received for a unit price basis.
