The City of Tupelo, Mississippi will receive written sealed bids for Bid 1526DS, **DEMOLITION AND DEBRIS REMOVAL AT PRESIDENT'S GATE APARTMENT COMPLEX** until **10 am on the 7th day of September, 2018**, at City Hall, 71 East Troy Street, First Floor Purchasing Office, Attention: Missy Shelton. Said bids will be opened and read aloud in the City Council Chambers on the Second Floor of City Hall.

Bids are related to the demolition and debris removal of seventeen (17) two story, wood frame buildings formerly used as multi-family dwellings. Demolition includes removal of building superstructures. Possible add alternates include concrete slab foundation removal, and backfilling and grassing of building sites.
