The Engineer will be responsible
for performing all engineering
services through project closeout
in accordance with federal, state,
and local laws, regulations and
policies. The scope of work in-
cludes but is not limited to the fol-
lowing: 1) prepare preliminary
cost estimate and preliminary en-
gineering report, 2) prepare plans
and specifications, 3) distribute bid
documents, 4) assist in bid open-
ing and prepare bid tabulation, 5)
assist in the execution of construc-
tion contracts, 6) hold pre-con-
struction conference, and 7)
perform construction inspection
and construction engineering in-
cluding periodic reports to the City
of Tupelo and review all payment
requests.

The City of Tupelo is an Equal
Opportunity Employer. The City of
Tupelo encourages Minority-owned
Business Enterprises (MBEs) and
Woman-owned Business Enter-
prises (WBEs) to submit proposals.

All proposals must be submitted
in a sealed envelope and marked
with the following language:
"PROPOSAL FOR ENGINEERING
SERVICES - SEWER INFRASTRUC-
TURE IMPROVEMENTS (1541WL)".
Proposals will be evaluated on the
following factors: Qualifications,
(40 points), Experience (40 points)
and Capacity for Performance (20
points). To be evaluated properly,
the following must be addressed in
detail:

Qualifications - List of qualifica-
tions of person to be assigned to
project;

Experience - Information regard-

ing the firm's experience and the
projects previously undertaken, in-
cluding the type and amount of
grants awarded, the projects activ-
ities, and the status of projects;

Capacity for Performance - Iden-
tify the number and title of staff
assigned to provide services.

The City of Tupelo will evaluate
each proposal. They may hold
proposals for a period of not to ex-
ceed thirty (30) days for the pur-
pose of reviewing the content of
the proposals and investigating the
qualifications of the firms and as-
signed individuals. The City of Tu-
pelo reserves the right to reject
any/or all proposals.

Subject to the removal of all en-
vironmental conditions, the City of
Tupelo will award a contract with
the qualified individual or firm
whose proposal has the highest
number of cumulative points is-
sued by the selection committee
and determined to be the most ad-
vantageous to the City of Tupelo,
price and other factors considered.
The contract will include scope and
extent of work and other essential
requirements. An individual con-
tract will be executed for the
awarded project and the contract
will be on a fixed price basis. The
City of Tupelo has the authority to
terminate the selection at any
time.
