Sealed Bids for construction of the 2023 Ruleville Drainage Improvement Project (Phase 1), will be received, by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Ruleville, MS at the office of the City Hall, 200 Floyce Street, Ruleville, MS 38771, until 6:00 o'clock PM, Central Time, on June 13, 2023, and then at said time and place publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of ditch cleaning and re-grading of ditches in the residential areas of the City of Ruleville, along Skeeter Robertson Road and East Sunflower Street. The project will also include the installation of 12", 15" and 18" HDPE pipes and the repair of damaged driveway culverts.

Plan holders will be required to have a valid email address and must purchase the Bidding Documents in order to be eligible to submit a Bid. Bids may be submitted in person or by mail. For delivery in person or by mail, the Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, plainly marked on the outside with the following: Bid for City of Ruleville, Mississippi, 2023 Ruleville Drainage Improvement Project (Phase 1), to be opened on June 6, 2023, and addressed to the City of Ruleville, MS, 200 Floyce Street, Ruleville, MS 38771. In addition, the envelope shall list the bidder's Company Name, address and applicable state and local license and registration numbers of the bidder. The Owner and Engineer assume no responsibility for the premature opening of any bid envelope which is not properly marked.

Bidders must be properly licensed by the MS State Board of Contractors for the type of Work required for this project. The owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids. Each bidder must deposit, with its bid, security in the amount of, form of and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract, including Section 3, Segregated Facility, Section 109 and E.O. 11246. Title VI Minority Bidders are encouraged to bid.

Bid Security in the amount of five (5) percent of the maximum total bid amount is required. No bidder may withdraw its bid within thirty (30) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
