- A. Notice is hereby given that sealed Bids will be received by City of Hernando for the Kuykendall Park Restroom Building, located in Hernando, Mississippi until 2:00 pm local standard time on the 9th day of November 2023.

1.04 TO: POTENTIAL BIDDERS

- A. Copies of the plans and contract documents may be obtained at the Office of the Hernando City Clerk from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.
- B. Official bid documents may be downloaded from Central Bidding at www.centralbidding.com. Electronic bids can also be submitted at www.centralbidding.com. For any questions relating to the electronic bidding procedures, please call Central Bidding at 225-810-4814.
- C. Partial Sets will not be issued.
- D. The Owner is an Equal Opportunity Employer. The Owner encourages Minority-owned Business Enterprises (MBEs) and Women-owned Business Enterprises (WBEs) to submit proposals.
- E. Bidders will be required to provide Bid Security in the form of a Bid Bond in the amount of 5% of the Base Bid.
- F. Refer to other bidding requirements described in Section 00 2113 - Instructions to Bidders and Section 00 3100 - Available Project Information.
- G. Submit your offer on the Bid Form provided. Bidders may supplement this form as appropriate, and as allowed by the State of Mississippi Public Bid Laws.
- H. Submit your Bid in Duplicate for hand delivered bid packages only.
- I. Your offer will be required to be submitted under a condition of irrevocability for a period of 30 (thirty) calendar days after submission.
- J. The bid will be awarded to the lowest responsive responsible and qualified bidder. The Owner reserves the right to waive any irregularities, the right to reject one or all bids and the option to postpone action and final decision for a period of up to forty-five (45) calendar days.
- K. Bidders must be properly licensed at the time of the bid and provide evidence of compliance with the applicable provisions of Section 31-3-21 (or latest revision) of Mississippi Code before such bid may be considered.

- L. All bids submitted in excess of \$50,000 by a prime or subcontractor to do any erection, building, construction, repair, maintenance, or related work must comply with the Mississippi Contractors Act of 1985 by securing a Certificate of Responsibility from the State Board of Contractors. The Prime Bidder's Certificate Number must be placed on the outside of the sealed envelope, or the bid will not be opened. Subcontractors requiring a Certificate of Responsibility must be listed, including their Certificate of Responsibility Number, on the Sub-Contractor List with the Bid.
