Tunica Main Street may hold proposals for a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days for the purpose of reviewing the content of the proposals and investigating the qualifications of the firms and assigned individuals. Tunica Main Street reserves the right to reject any and/or all proposals and waive any irregularities.

Tunica Main Street will award a contract with the qualified individual or firm whose proposal has the highest number of cumulative points issued by the board and determined to be the most advantageous to the organization, price and other factors considered. The contract will include scope and extent of work and other essential requirements. An individual contract will be executed for each awarded project, and the contract will be on a fixed price basis. Tunica Main Street has the authority to terminate the selection at any time.
