**NOTICE FOR BIDS
HARVEY CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS
MADISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI**

Sealed bids will be received by the Madison County Board of Supervisors until 10 AM on May 29, 2018, for the Harvey Crossing Improvements project. All bids so received will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after this time will not be accepted, and will be returned unopened.

Bids may be submitted by either of the following methods:

1. Sealed bids will be received until 10 AM on May 29, 2018, at the Madison County Chancery Clerk's Office, Rooms 225-228, 146 West North Street, Canton, MS, 39046. All sealed bids submitted to the Chancery Clerk's office shall be marked on the outside face of the envelope "Bid: Harvey Crossing Improvements" and shall have the bidder's name and certificate of responsibility number written on the outside of the envelope. If any envelope is not so marked, said bid shall not be opened and considered.
2. Electronic bids will be received until 10 AM on May 29, 2018, as a PDF via Madison County's website at <http://www.madison-co.com/bids>. Each bidder submitting a bid electronically as a PDF file shall include its Certificate of Responsibility Number as part of its PDF electronic bid submittal. Any electronic PDF bid that does not include the bidder's certificate of responsibility number shall not be considered.

The project generally consists of the reconstruction of approximately 1,800 linear feet of two-lane asphalt paved, curb and gutter roadway. It also includes removal of selected trees from the right-of-way.
