Sealed bids for wastewater treatment facility improvements for the Town of Prentiss, Jefferson Davis County, Mississippi, will be received by the Mayor and Board of Alderman, until 2:00 PM local time on June 28, 2022, at the City Hall, 911 3rd Street, Prentiss, MS 39474, and shortly thereafter will be opened and publicly read.

The work involved in the project includes new aerators, electrical controls, chain link fencing, repair/replace wave action pads, chlorination equipment, etc. as described in the project Construction Drawings and Contract Documents. All documents required for submitting a bid are furnished by Dungan Engineering, P.A., 1574 Highway 98 East, Columbia, Mississippi 39429, 601-731-2600.

This construction project is financed by the Mississippi Development Authority, Community Incentives Division, by a Community Development Block Grant through the Small Government Public Facilities Category, 1138-21-308-PF-01, and is subject to the rules and regulations of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 and all amendments thereof. Neither the United States nor any departments, agencies, or employees is, or will be, a part of this Invitation for Proposals or any resulting contract.

The successful bidder must comply with Section 3 of the HUD Act of 1968 and its associated regulations (24 C.F.R., Part 75). CDBG regulations governing the grant require that, to the greatest extent feasible opportunities for contracting, subcontracting, training and employment arising in connection with this CDBG project will be extended to Section 3 businesses Targeted Section 3 Workers, and Section 3 Workers.

Minority and Woman Owned Business Enterprises are solicited to bid on this contract as prime contractors and are encouraged to make inquiries regarding potential subcontracting opportunities, equipment, material and/or supply needs.

The **Town of Prentiss** is an Equal Opportunity Employer, and hereby notifies all bidders will be afforded the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, disability, sexual preference, marital or veteran status, or any other legally protected status in consideration for an award.

The successful bidder must comply with the Davis-Bacon Act which requires that all laborers and mechanics shall be paid at rates not less than those determined by the Department of Labor to be prevailing for the locality in which the project is located.

Bid preparation will be in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders bound in the Documents. The Mayor and Board of Alderman reserve the right to waive irregularities and to reject any and/or all bids.
