The Lamar County Board of Supervisors, Lamar County, Mississippi, will receive bids for the Widening, Overlay and Improvements & Multi-Use Pathway on Old Highway 11 for a total project length of 2.742 miles, Federal Aid Project No. STP-8775-00(001)LPA / 107040-701000 & 702000 no later than 2:00 p.m., Local Time, December 15, 2022, at the William "Pete" Gamble Chancery Courthouse, Supervisor's Office located at 403 Main Street, Purvis, Mississippi. All bids so received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work shall consist essentially of the following items:

Widen, Overlay, Curb & Gutter, with Center Turn Lane Along Old Hwy 11 from  
Hattiesburg Corporate Limits South with 10' Multi-Use Pathway

All other related items of work required to complete the project as shown and specified in  
the Contract Documents.

The above general outline of features of the work does not in any way limit the responsibility of the contractor to perform all work and furnish all plant, labor, equipment and materials required by the specifications and the drawings referred to therein.

The attention of bidders is directed to the Contract Provisions governing selection and employment of labor. Minimum wage rates for Federal-Aid projects have been predetermined by the Secretary of Labor and are subject to Public Law 87-581 Work Hours Act of 1962, as set forth in the Contract Provisions.

The Lamar County Board of Supervisors of Lamar County hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged and women's business enterprises will be afforded the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

**The award of this contract will be contingent upon the Contractor satisfying the DBE/WBE requirements.**

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Cashier's check, Certified Check on a solvent bank or a Bidder's Bond issued by a Surety Company licensed to operate in the State of Mississippi, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid price, payable to Lamar County, Mississippi as bid security. Bidders shall also submit a current financial statement, if requested by the County. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount.
