Proposals for 500 GPM water well for the Town of Prentiss, Jefferson Davis County, Mississippi, will be received by the Mayor and Board of Alderman, until 3:00 PM local time on December 5, 2017, at the City Hall, 911 3rd Street, Prentiss, MS 39474, and shortly thereafter will be opened and publicly read.

The work involved in the project includes construction of a new 500 GPM water well as described in the project Construction Drawings and Contract Documents. All documents required for submitting a proposal are furnished by Dungan Engineering, P.A., 1574 Highway 98 East, Columbia, Mississippi 39429, 601-731-2600.

This construction project is financed by the Mississippi Development Authority, Community Services Division, by a Community Development Block Grant through the Small Government Public Facilities Category, 1133-17-308-PF-01, and is subject to the rules and regulations of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 and all amendments thereof. Neither the United States nor any departments, agencies, or employees is, or will be, a part of this Invitation for Proposals or any resulting contract.

The Town of Prentiss is an Equal Opportunity Employer. Minority and women's business enterprises are solicited to bid on this contract as prime contractors and are encouraged to make inquiries regarding potential subcontracting opportunities and equipment, material and/or supply needs. The Town of Prentiss hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged and women's business enterprises will be afforded the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The work to be performed under this Contract is subject to the requirements of Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968 (24 CFR 135). Section 3 regulations require that, to the greatest extent feasible, opportunities for contracting, subcontracting, training, and employment arising in connection with the CDBG Project will be extended to Section 3 Resident and Section Business Concerns. Section 3 Business Concerns are solicited to bid on this contract as prime contractors and are encouraged to make inquiries regarding potential subcontracting opportunities to Section 3 Business Concerns.

In order to comply with Federal Procurement Regulations (24 CFR 85), Minority and Woman Owned Business Enterprises are encouraged to submit a bid for this project. The successful bidder will take all necessary affirmative steps to assure that Minority and Woman Owned Business Enterprises are used when possible as subcontractors on this project.

Davis Bacon Act: The Contractor shall pay labor rates set forth by "wage rates" as mandated by the U.S. Department of Labor.

Proposal preparation will be in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders bound in the Documents. The Mayor and Board of Alderman reserve the right to waive irregularities and to reject any and/or all bids.
