Sealed bids will be received until **Monday, May 21, 2018, 2:00 PM**, and then publicly opened and read at Town of Prentiss City Hall, for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment and performing all work necessary to: Complete the Airport Improvements Project 2018. Construction will include Runway and Taxiway Surface Treatment and Runway and Taxiway Markings.

Contract award will be contingent on receiving project funding approval.
