INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

1. The Clarksdale Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) may consider informal any bid not prepared and submitted in accordance with the provisions hereof and may waive any informalities or reject any and all bids. Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof, provided that the request is signed in the same manner and by the same person who signed the proposal. Any bid received after the time and date specified shall not be considered. No bidder may withdraw a bid after the actual date of the opening thereof.

2. <u>Preparation of Bid</u>

<u>Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed form</u>. All blank spaces for bid prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, in both words and figures.

Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing on the outside of the envelope the name of the bidder, his address, and the statement "Quote for the Purchase of Damaged Vehicles."

3. Electronic Modification

Any bidder may modify his bid in writing or by electronic communication at any time prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids, provided such communication is received by CPUC prior to the closing time, and, provided further, CPUC is satisfied that a written confirmation of the modification over the signature of the bidder was mailed prior to the closing time. The communication should not reveal the bid price but should provide the addition or subtraction or other modification so that the final prices or terms will not be known by CPUC until the sealed bid is opened. 5. Responsibility of Bidder to Know Conditions

Each bidder must inform himself fully of the condition, location, and loading and hauling requirements of each vehicle prior to submitting his proposal. Failure to do so will not relieve him of his obligations under terms of his bid and contract.

6. Addenda and Interpretations

Any and all such interpretation and any supplemental instructions will be in the form of written addenda to the specifications which, is issued, will be mailed by certified mail with return receipt requested to all prospective bidders (at the respective address furnished for such purposes), not later than three days prior to the date fixed for the opening of bids. Failure of any bidder to receive such addendum or interpretation shall not relieve such bidder from any obligation under his bid as submitted. All addenda so issued shall become part of the contract documents.

7. <u>Laws and Regulations</u>

The bidder's attention is directed to the fact that all applicable State laws and CPUC's rules and regulations shall apply to the bidding and purchase throughout, and they will be deemed to be included in the contract the same as though herein written out in full.

8. Method of Award

The award shall be made to the bidder, who, in the opinion of CPUC, best meets the necessary requirements with the highest and best bid.

The CPUC reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality.

9. Obligation of Bidder

At the time of the opening of bids each bidder will be presumed to have read and to be thoroughly familiar with the condition of each vehicle, its accessibility and its transportability. The failure or omission of any bidder to familiarize himself with such matters shall in no way relieve any bidder from obligation with respect to his bid. The sale of the vehicles by CPUC shall be "as is—where is." All warranties other than of title are expressly disclaimed.

11. Taxes

CPUC is a governmental entity exempt from the payment of sales tax; however, all other taxes that might lawfully be assessed against the Seller or CPUC in the sale or delivery of the Transformers are to be paid by the Seller. It is to be clearly understood by all bidders that the bid price submitted shall include the total cost of such taxes, if any.

12. Variance of Terms and Conditions

The Bidder is presumed to know the laws and statutes of Mississippi applicable to the CPUC, which is a municipal commission. Without in any way limiting the foregoing, CPUC cannot accept and the Bidder may not submit ANY TERM OR CONDITION to the purchase from CPUC of such Transformers WHICH PURPORTS TO:

- 1) LIMIT THE LIABILITY OF THE BIDDER EITHER IN AMOUNT OR TYPE OF DAMAGES;
- 2) LIMIT OR MODIFY ANY PERIOD OF LIMITATIONS ESTABLISHED BY STATUTE;
- 3) REQUIRE THE CPUC TO INDEMNIFY BIDDER AGAINST CLAIMS ARISING IN WHOLE, OR IN PART, FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF BIDDER OR OTHERS OR FROM ACTIONABLE DEEDS OF BIDDER OR OTHERS; OR

The contract between the CPUC and the successful bidder shall be deemed to include the terms, provisions, conditions, and agreements of the Advertisement for Bids, Information for Bidders, Notice of Award, and any addenda thereto or written interpretation thereof. Each shall be considered an integral component of the contract between the CPUC and the Successful Bidder.
