

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

LAWRENCE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS CONERLY ROAD BASE AND PAVEMENT REHABILITATION LAWRENCE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

Sealed bids for the Conerly Road Base and Pavement Rehabilitation for the Lawrence County Board of Supervisors in Lawrence County, Mississippi, will be received by Mr. Steve Garrett, President of the Lawrence County Board of Supervisors, Mississippi, until 10:00 AM local time on November 4, 2019, at the Board Room located at 517 East Broad Street, Monticello, MS 39654, and shortly thereafter will be opened and publicly read.

The work involved in the project includes roadbed reclamation, base repairs, leveling, and re-seal of Conerly Road in Lawrence County, Mississippi. The construction shall meet the requirements of the plans and contract documents. All documents required for bidding purposes may be obtained from Dungan Engineering, P. A., 120 East Chickasaw Street, Brookhaven, Mississippi 39601, (601) 823-7026. A non-refundable deposit of \$50.00 is required at the time of request for Construction Drawings and Contract Documents. A copy of the Contract Drawings and Documents may be examined at the office of Dungan Engineering, P. A., 120 East Chickasaw Street, Brookhaven, Mississippi 39602.

Bid preparation will be in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders bound in the Contract Documents. The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to waive irregularities and to reject any and/or all bids.

A bid bond or certified check in the amount of 5% of the bid will be required. The bid bond or certified check will be returned immediately to unsuccessful bidders. Bidders are hereby notified that any proposal accompanied by letters qualifying in any manner the condition under which the proposal is tendered will be considered an irregular bid and such proposals will not be considered in making the award.

A performance bond, or equal, in the full amount of the contract will be required of the successful bidder. In lieu of a performance bond the successful bidder may post with the Lawrence County Board of Supervisors, the full amount of the bid, in cash or its equivalent, conditioned for the prompt, proper and efficient performance of the contract; said cash or its equivalent to be held until the successful completion of the project.

Attention is called to the fact that contracts exceeding \$50,000 require contractors to be licensed under applicable laws of the State of Mississippi and have a certificate of responsibility.
