All bids so received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work shall consist essentially of the following items:

Raised concrete crosswalks, sidewalk, fencing, and other related items of work required to complete the project as shown and specified in the Contract Documents.

The above general outline of features of the work does not in any way limit the responsibility of the contractor to perform all work and furnish all plant, labor, equipment and materials required by the specifications and the drawings referred to therein.

The attention of bidders is directed to the Contract Provisions governing selection and employment of labor. Minimum wage rates for Federal-Aid projects have been predetermined by the Secretary of Labor and are subject to Public Law 87-581 Work Hours Act of 1962, as set forth in the Contract Provisions.

The award of this contract will be contingent upon the Contractor satisfying the DBE/WBE requirements.

Bidders shall also submit a current financial statement, if requested by the County. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount.

The proposal and contract documents in its entirety shall be submitted in a sealed envelope and deposited with the Copiah Lincoln Community College, Ewing Administration Building, 1001 Co-Lin Dr. Wesson, MS 39191, Mississippi prior to the hour and date above designated.
