The contract will be awarded to the responsible offeror whose proposal is within the competitive range and determined to be the most advantageous to the project. 1. Qualifications-List of qualifications of each staff person to be assigned to the project.
2. Experience- Information regarding the experience of the firm. This should include the types of project activities undertaken.
3. Capacity for Performance- Identify the number and title of staff available to be assigned to provide services.

All proposals will be rated on the following system to determine the best offeror:

Qualifications – 40, Experience – 40, Capacity – 20, to Total: 100 points.
