Sealed bids for the construction of the SEWAGE COLLECTION IMPROVEMENTS – SIMMONS & ROBINSON STREET SEWER AND HORDGE LANE SEWER REHABILITATION shall be received by the Town of Edwards at City Hall, 310 Front Street, Edwards, MS 39066 until 10:00 am local time, May 3, 2019 at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Principal items of work are as follows:

- 1. Installation of multiple home simplex grinder station and control panel on Robinson Street,
- 2. Installation of a 1-1/4" to 2" PVC force main on Robinson Street,
- 3. Installation of multiple home simplex grinder station and control panel on Simmons Street,
- 4. Installation of a 1-1/4" to 2" PVC force main on Simmons Street,
- 5. Rehabilitation of 48" manholes on Hordge Lane using solid epoxy, and
- 6. Rehabilitation of 8" sewer on Hordge Lane using cured-in-place pipe.

Contract time shall be 240 consecutive calendar days from the effective date shown in the Notice to Proceed. Liquidated damages will be assessed in the amount of \$750.00 for each consecutive calendar day the work has not achieved Final Completion.

Bidder must be qualified under Mississippi Law and show current Certificate of Responsibility issued by the Mississippi State Board of Public Contractors establishing his classification as to the value and type of construction on which he is authorized to bid.

Each Bidder shall write his Certificate of Responsibility Number on the outside of the sealed envelope containing his proposal.

Proposals shall be submitted in duplicate, sealed and deposited with the Town of Edwards, Mississippi prior to the hour and date hereinbefore designated. No bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Each Bidder must submit with his proposal a separate attachment stating his qualifications to perform the Work. The Statement of Qualifications shall list past projects of similar size and nature, a list of references with name and telephone number, a list of key personnel who will perform the work, and other information supporting the bidder's qualifications.

Awarding public contracts to non-resident Bidders will be on the same basis as the non-resident bidder's state awards contracts to Mississippi Contractors bidding under similar circumstances. In order to ensure that Mississippi's so-called Golden Rule is followed state law requires a non-resident bidder to attach to his bid a copy of his resident state's current laws pertaining to such state's treatment of non-resident contractors.
