The Union Public School District is seeking Requests for Qualifications (RFQ) for architectural and engineering design services and management related, but not limited to, the following project(s):

Responses shall be mailed or hand delivered to 417 S. Decatur St., Union, MS 39365 and must be received no later than April 27, 2021 at 4:00 pm CST. Packages or envelopes must be clearly labeled with “**RFQ #364.**”

NOTE: These federally funded projects must be completed on or before September 30, 2023 if financed by ESSER II funding and September 30, 2024 if financed by ESSER III funding.

In your submittal, please include the following:

1. Firm background and history.
2. Qualifications, including resumes, of team members and any sub-consultants in the area of the projects described above.
3. Examples of experience with relevant and federally funded projects.
4. Certification that your firm or members of your firm have not been disbarred, suspended, or otherwise excluded from or ineligible for participation in federal assistance programs or activities.
