WHEREAS, Walthall County has need of services for providing disaster debris monitoring and for providing disaster debris removal and disposal, and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of Walthall County, Mississippi and its people that advertisement be made for services for providing disaster debris monitoring and for providing disaster debris removal and disposal.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the Clerk of this Board be authorized and directed to cause to be published in the *Tylertown Times*, in the manner provided by law, the following notice, to-wit:

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Walthall County, Mississippi Board of Supervisors will receive sealed bids until 10:00 o'clock A.M., on Monday, April 1, 2024, and will open such bids as soon thereafter as conveniently possible for general supplies and services as herein below mentioned:

For the period of time from April, 2024 through December, 2024, said materials, supplies and services being generally defined and described as follows, to-wit:

(A) Proposals from qualified companies for providing disaster debris monitoring. The successful proposer will be required to enter into a contract to provide said services for a period ending the First Monday of January, 2025. All applicants must illustrate in their Proposal the ability to meet the required criteria set forth in the RFP, including, but not limited to, the ability to illustrate a company history of providing like services in similar communities with satisfactory performance verifiable through provided references.
