

Four responses to this IFB were received and opened on 10/06/17, with two (2) of the responders being present. The bid response received from Christopher King Enterprises, which was the lowest bid, was deemed unresponsive, because only three (3) of the four (4) required licenses were furnished.

A pre-proposal conference was held on 9/15/17. Seven (7) prospective proposers were present.

After evaluation of responses, we request that the award of the contract for IFB #3160001243, be made to Rotolo Consultants. This contract will be for an initial thirty six (36) month period, 12/01/2017-11/30/2020, with the option of renewing the contract for two (2) one (1) year terms. Total contract amount for the initial 36 month term is \$239,877.99. This total includes the base bid, in the amount of \$53,613.85/yr., as well as, Alternate #1, in the amount of \$16,165.19/yr., and Alternate #2, in the amount of \$10,180.29/yr.

There were two amendments issued.

Agency legal staff has reviewed and signed off on contract.

Notifications of intent to award were sent via e-mail on 10/09/2017.

I certify that adequate time to protest has been given to all prospective contractors, and that no protest or potential protests are known to the agency or agency employees.
