Sealed bids will be received by the Natchez Water Works Board of Water Commissioners of the City of Natchez, office of the Natchez Water Works, 150 North Shields Lane, Natchez, Mississippi, until **4:00 P.M.** on **Tuesday, November 20, 2018**, and bids will be publicly opened at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Natchez Water Works Board of Water Commissioners of the City of Natchez, office of the Natchez Water Works, 150 North Shields Lane, Natchez, Mississippi, for **Project No. 011-18-WW, WATERLINE EXTENSION HWY 61 SOUTH**, in the City of Natchez, Mississippi.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The main items of work consist of construction of potable water transmission main, storage tank and booster pumping station.

- The waterline extension's main items of work shall consist of the installation of approximately 1,650 linear feet of six (6) inch ductile iron pipe, approximately 4,450 linear feet of ten (10) inch ductile iron pipe, fittings, fire hydrants, valves and one connection to an existing six (6) inch ductile iron water main.
- The booster pumping station's main items of work shall consist of the installation of two (2) 500 gpm booster pumps, valves, piping, fittings, electrical and control system, one (1) 60,000 gal storage tank and one (1) 20,000 hydro pneumatic tank system with air compressor.
- The project includes furnishing all labor, equipment, tools, and materials necessary to construct the project, complete-in-place and functional, as shown on the Plans and Specifications.

A certified check or bid bond for **5%** of the total Bid, payable to the Natchez Water Works, Natchez, Mississippi, must accompany each proposal. Bidders are hereby notified that any proposal accompanied by letters qualifying in any manner, the condition under which the proposals are tendered, will be considered an irregular bid and such proposals will not be considered in making the award.

The Natchez Water Works will conduct a pre-bid conference for all interested contractors, 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, November 7, 2018 at the office of Natchez Water Works, 150 North Shields Lane, Natchez, Mississippi.

The award, if made, will be made to the lowest and best bidder on the basis of the published quantities, who is considered qualified by the board. The board reserves the right to waive informalities and to reject any and all bids.
