The award recommendation decision was based on information provided in each proposal. The information below supports the decision for this recommendation. Comments on the strengths and weaknesses were expounded upon in the individual rubrics. After thorough evaluations and great consideration, it is a recommendation to award **Data Recognition Corporation** the contract for the Mississippi Academic Assessment Program, Science (MAAP-SCI) Grade 5 and Grade 8 and Mississippi Academic Assessment Program, End of Course (MAAP-EOC) Biology and U.S. History RFx3120001410.

Overall

- o Not well organized
- o Table of Contents was very general
- o References to different sections were confusing and illogical
- Did not give a distinct view of the process
- Main facts at the end of the proposal
- Scaling and equating format did not clarify the direction to be taken to verify scoring
- Mentioned many other companies to help in the process; not enough "in-house" processing

The following reason was also given as one of the overall reasons Questar was not chosen. This offeror has a proprietary statistics program to run some of their equating. If it is proprietary, they are probably not going to tell the MDE and they are not being forthright. The MDE needs to know exactly what is being done with the programs and equating and scoring. Everyone is using the same method, but this offeror mentioned that they have the proprietary program that they are using. The MDE should want them to be a little more open with an attitude and practice of transparency.

Below are additional weaknesses, provided by rubric areas, that Questar was not chosen.

Item and Test Development

- o Did not adhere to RFP requests in terms of educators used for item development
- Use of non-teacher, contract writers in Years 1 and 2
- Specified 40 operational items for 5-8 Science, but RFP requires 50 operational items
- Only 1/3 of teacher-created items for Year 1

Support Materials and Manuals

 No discussion or specifics on how many forms they would provide for large-print or Braille even though RFP was specific

Test Administration

- o Did not mention Linux which MDE had as a minimum tech. standard
- Refreshable Braille files not available but committed to having them ready by Spring 2019
- Workplan not clearly defined

Distribution and Collection

Quality control procedures lacked specifics

• Score Reports and Results

- o Vague
- Does not seem to have a plan in place for the quick turn- around time for graded assessments/student scores

Project Management

- Doesn't look like many workers are allocated to this project for Year 1. "As Needed" was seen a lot
- o Vague
- Stated that transition plan was in Appendix C, but the plan was not there.
