The ADSi MapForce AVL system will provide the ability to track the movement of emergency response apparatus (helicopters, automobiles, motorcycles, ATV's, etc). The system will also provide integration with the Mississippi Highway Patrol for incidents where both agencies are working jointly. This greatly enhanced interoperability will provide emergency responders, dispatchers, and their supervisors, the means to coordinate a joint response using real-time location information. The ADSi MapForce AVL system provides the means to selectively enable and disable the incidents that can be viewed by each agency.

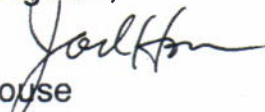
The system also provides for enhanced emergency responder safety by providing a location in a time of assistance. For instance, at MHP the system provides the capability to quickly locate a trooper and send backup, or medical help, when needed.

Because the ADSi MapForce AVL system has been purchased, installed, and is currently running live at MHP, no other vendor can provide a seamless common interface for use at UMMC that will be interoperable with MHP.
