

MDHS selected to award RFP No. AAS-APS-2018-001 to ten (10) Mississippi based Planning & Development Districts (PDD) as identified in the hereby attached and incorporated Exhibit A.

ANALYSIS DESCRIBING AWARD, RENEWAL OR AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT:

MDHS issued RFP No. AAS-APS-2018-001 on June 7, 2018. MDHS received eleven (11) responses from the following Bidders: Liberty Healthcare, Inc. (Liberty) and ten (10) Mississippi PDD's. Each PDD proposed to provide services for a region of Mississippi to include specific counties. When considered collectively, the PDD's could provide services statewide. Liberty's response also included provision of services statewide. The proposed costs submitted in each PDD response was totaled and compared against the cost provided by Liberty. Liberty's proposed cost was approximately 31% higher than the combined proposed cost of the PDD's. MDHS rejected Liberty's response pursuant to PPRB Rule 3-301.05(3)(b) because of unreasonableness of price. The PDD's scored the highest during the evaluation and provided the lowest price; therefore, MDHS awarded ten (10) separate contracts to the PDD's to provide statewide coverage of services. The duration of each contract is for three (3) years.

MDHS received eleven (11) responses to the above referenced Request For Proposals (RFP) issued on June 7, 2018. Ranking of the responses is provided below in order of evaluation:

Liberty	89.00*
PDDs	88.50

\*Response rejected due to unreasonable price.

MDHS recommends to award a contract to each Planning & Development District (PDD) for a total contract cost of \$6,492,668.00. Each contract will be for a term of three (3) years to begin of the first day of the month following the Public Procurement Review Board's approval.

Each PDD proposed to provide services for a region of Mississippi to include specific counties. When considered collectively, the PPD's can provide statewide coverage of services. Liberty's response also included provision of services statewide. The proposed costs submitted in each PDD response was totaled and compared against the cost provided by Liberty. Liberty's proposed cost was approximately 31% higher than the combined proposed cost of the PDD's. MDHS rejected Liberty's response pursuant to PPRB Rule 3-301.05(3)(b) because of unreasonableness of price. The PDD's scored the highest during the evaluation and provided the lowest price.
