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GENERAL CONDITIONS

In accordance with the Section 29-13-5 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, the Mississippi Department of Finance and Administration (DFA or Department) is conducting a procurement process for the purpose of selecting a commercial property business valuation/appraisal company for **Building Appraisal / Valuation Services on Buildings only, not Personal Property (hereafter referred to as “services”)**. The DFA currently provides property insurance coverage to thirty (30) State agencies on approximately 4,200 structures valued at approximately \$5.661 Billion, excluding those properties (Mississippi Public Universities, Community Colleges, and Junior Colleges) that come under the direction of the Mississippi Institutions of Higher Learning (IHL). The DFA desires to enter into a contract with a company with demonstrated expertise and directly related prior experience in providing such services to public entities and large private sector entities.

THE EFFECTIVE DATE

The effective date of this contract is August 15, 2018. The term of this contract will be for no more than a four (4) year period with an option to renew for one (1) year at DFA’s discretion. Compensation for building appraisal / valuation services rendered under this contract will be on a flat fee basis, except where indicated otherwise. The contract will be a Fixed-Price Contract with Price Adjustment (See Public Procurement Review Board Office of Personal Service Contract Review Rules & Regulations, Section 3-501.04.3). See Exhibit A for an example of the Personal Service Contract.

ONLINE COPY OF IFB

A copy of this IFB will be posted on DFA’s website at www.dfa.state.ms.gov. It can be found under the bottom heading “**BID/ RFP NOTICES**” and under “Office of State Property Insurance”. Before the award of any contract, the Bidder will be required to provide sufficient evidence to prove to the DFA that it has the necessary capabilities to provide the services in the Invitation For Bid (IFB) at the time the contract is awarded. The purpose of this IFB is to solicit competitive sealed bids by defining the Department’s need, providing companies adequate information to develop bids, describing the evaluation criteria on which bids will be scored and providing Bidders with a standard contract in substantial form.

A schedule of current State of Mississippi buildings that require appraisal / valuation services is included in this IFB, Exhibit B. Bidder will not be at a competitive disadvantage if it does not have an office in the State of Mississippi. There is no required or minimum number of meetings with Bidder, but is solely dictated on level of business-need basis. Other information may be provided to the Bidders if the Department deems it relevant to the solicitation process.

INSTRUCTIONS AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

All potential Bidders are requested to indicate their intention to propose, and submit any questions they have regarding the bid in writing by May 7, 2018, 2:00 PM CST. Intent to Propose should be submitted by email to george.roberson@dfa.ms.gov along with any questions if they exist. Your intent to propose should indicate your organization's primary contact, along with the contact's mailing address, direct telephone number, email address and facsimile number. All Bidders submitting an Invitation for Bid will receive a copy of all questions and responses via email on or before May 14, 2018 by 5:00 PM CST. A copy of all questions and responses will also be posted to the DFA website as illustrated in Section 1, page 3, paragraph 3 of this IFB. Failure to submit an Intent to Propose will not disqualify a Company from responding to this IFB.

BID RECEIPT DATE

Bids must be received in the DFA's Budget & Accounting/Purchasing Department in Jackson Mississippi by 2:00 pm Central Daylight Time, Tuesday May 29, 2018. Any bid received after the deadline will not be considered. Bids received by fax or electronic mail will NOT be accepted. Bids must be submitted in writing and electronic copy via flash drive or CD with appropriate signatures as required.

Discussions may be conducted with Bidders who submit bids determined to be reasonably susceptible of being selected for award, but bids may be accepted without such discussions. Bid price is to be submitted along with bid, at the time of bid submission. All submitted bids shall be in writing, in addition to the electronic methods of distribution discussed below. Contract will be governed by the Department. Bidders may designate those portions of the bids which contain trade secrets or other proprietary data which may remain confidential in accordance with 1972 Mississippi Code Annotated §§ 25-61-9 and 79-23-1.

The IFB envelope shall be clearly marked on the front with the IFB #, opening date, and time. Submit one clearly marked original response with signed bid cover letter. Include two (2) identical copies of the original response in three-ring binders or wire-bound binders and include one electronic copy of the complete bid including all sections in Microsoft Office ® format with appendices in the appropriate Microsoft Office ® format or Portable Document Format (PDF) on flash drive or compact disc. Failure to sign and return these required documents may result in disqualification of the bid. To prevent opening by unauthorized individuals, all copies of the bid must be sealed in the package, and the package must be marked, "Bids – Do Not Open."

In preparing your written response to any IFB question or request for information, repeat each question or requirement followed by your response. Please provide complete answers and explain all issues in a concise, direct manner.

The Department will use the information contained in your bid to determine whether you will be selected for contract negotiations. The bid the Department selects will be a working document. As such, the Department will consider the bid an integral part of the contract and will expect the Bidder to honor all representations made in its bid.

It is the Bidder's sole responsibility to submit information relative to the evaluation of its bid and the Department is under no obligation to solicit such information if it is not included with the Bidder's bid. Failure of the Bidder to submit such information in a manner that is easily located and understood may have an adverse impact on the evaluation of the Bidder's bid.

All documentation submitted in response to this IFB and any subsequent requests for information pertaining to this IFB shall become the property of the Department and will not be returned to the Bidder.

PRIMARY SERVICE

The primary service to be rendered by the selected company is to assist the Department in performing appraisal / valuation services for the buildings identified in Exhibit B. To accomplish this task the company will be expected to:

Work with and be responsive to the Department in all areas customarily related to performing appraisal services on commercial buildings;

Advise and consult with the Department as to the type and format of data that needs to be collected and maintained for proper valuations;

Exclude from the Services any appraisal or valuation of personal property, land, land improvements, or infrastructure;

Provide these stated Scope of Services for a period of at least four (4) calendar years, with an option to extend these services one (1) additional calendar year with a decision from the Department and adequate notice given and agreed upon to Bidder.

The buildings identified in Exhibit B are the properties requiring normal valuation/appraisal services for this Bid.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. APPLICABLE LAW

The contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Mississippi, excluding its conflicts of laws, provisions, and litigation with respect thereto shall be bought in the courts of the State. Contractor shall comply with applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

2. AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS

It is expressly understood and agreed that the obligation of the DFA to proceed under this agreement is conditioned upon the appropriation of funds by the Mississippi State Legislature and the receipt of state and/or federal funds. If the funds anticipated for the continuing fulfillment of the agreement are, at any time, not forthcoming or insufficient, either through the failure of the federal government to provide funds or of the State of Mississippi to appropriate funds or if funds are not otherwise available to the DFA, the DFA shall have the right upon ten (10) working days written notice to Contractor, to terminate this agreement without damage, penalty, cost or expenses to the DFA of any kind whatsoever. The effective date of termination shall be as specified in the notice of termination.

3. PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS

The contract shall be governed by the applicable provisions of the Mississippi Public Procurement Review Board Office of Personal Service Contract Review Rules and Regulations, a copy of which is available at 501 North West Street, Suite 701E, Jackson, MS 39201 for inspection, or downloadable at <http://www.dfa.ms.gov>.

4. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

Contractor understands that the DFA is an equal opportunity employer and therefore, maintains a policy which prohibits unlawful discrimination based on race, color, creed, sex, age, national origin, physical handicap, disability, genetic information, or any other consideration made unlawful by federal, state, or local laws. All such discrimination is unlawful and Contractor agrees during the term of the agreement that Contractor will strictly adhere to this policy in its employment practices and provisions of services. Contractor shall comply with, and all activities under this agreement shall be subject to, all applicable federal, State of Mississippi, and local laws and regulations, as now existing and as many be amended or modified.

5. DURATION OF BID

In the questionnaire section of the bid, the Bidder must confirm that the bid is valid for at least 180 days subsequent to the date of submission.

6. STOP WORK ORDER

(1) **Order to stop work** The Chief Procurement Officer, may by written order to the Contractor at any time, and without notice to any surety, require the Contractor to stop all or any part of the work called for by this Contract. This order shall be for a specified period not exceeding ninety (90) days after the order is delivered to the Contractor, unless the parties agree to any further period. Any such order shall be identified specifically as a stop work order issued pursuant to this clause. Upon receipt of such an order, the Contractor shall forthwith comply with its terms and take all reasonable steps to minimize the occurrence of costs allocable to work covered by the order during the period of work stoppage. Before the stop work order expires, or within any further period to which the parties shall have agreed, the Chief Procurement Officer shall either:

- (a) cancel the stop work order; or,
- (b) terminate the work covered by such order as provided in the "Termination for Default" clause or the "Termination for Convenience" clause of this Contract.

(2) **Cancellation or Expiration of the Order.** If a stop work order issued under this clause is cancelled at any time during the period specified in the order, or if the period of the order or any extension thereof expires, the Contractor shall have the right to resume work. An appropriate adjustment shall be made in the delivery

schedule or the Contractor price, or both, and the Contract shall be modified in writing accordingly, if:

- (a) the stop work order results in an increase in the time required for, or in the Contractor's cost properly allocable to, the performance of any part of this Contract; and,
 - (b) the Contractor asserts a claim for such an adjustment within thirty (30) days after the end of the period of work stoppage; provided that, if the Chief Procurement Officer decides that the facts justify such action, any such claim asserted may be received and acted upon at any time prior to final payment under this Contract.
- (3) **Termination of Stopped Work.** If a stop work order is not cancelled and the work covered by such order is terminated for default or convenience, the reasonable costs resulting from the stop work order shall be allowed by adjustment or otherwise.
- (4) **Adjustments of Price.** Any adjustment in contract price made pursuant to this clause shall be determined in accordance with the "Price Adjustment" clause of this Contract.

7. CORRECTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

The Department reserves the right to request clarifications or corrections to bids. Any bid received which does not follow the instructions to Bidders, meet the minimum Company qualifications or comply with other bid requirements of this IFB, including clarification or correction requests, may be considered to be "non-responsive" and be rejected.

8. WITHDRAWAL OR AMENDMENT OF A BID

A Bidder may withdraw a bid by submitting a written request to the Department for its withdrawal signed by the Bidder and mailed to the above contact. The Department shall not accept any amendments, revisions or alterations to bids after the due date.

9. COST OF BID

All costs incurred by the Bidder in preparing and delivering their bid, making on-site presentations (if deemed necessary) and any subsequent time and travel to meet with the Department regarding the bid shall be borne by the Bidder.

10. MISSISSIPPI PUBLIC RECORDS ACT/CONFIDENTIALITY OF BIDS

Any bid, including accompanying attachments, will be available for review by State of Mississippi personnel, the Department, members and staff of the Legislature and oversight boards and the Department's consultants. The bid is further subject to the "Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983", as amended, codified as Section 25-6-1 et seq., Mississippi Code Annotated and exceptions found in Sections 25-61-9 and 79-23-1. The Department understands that you may consider some of the information required to be provided in the bid to be proprietary. The Department requires that each page of the bid that you consider confidential be on a different color paper than non-confidential pages and be marked in the upper right hand corner with the word "CONFIDENTIAL". The State statute referenced above provides that you can request that prior to the release of any information under a public records request you will be notified by the Department of the request for the information and given sufficient time to seek protection from the appropriate court. If you do not obtain protection from the appropriate court, all information supplied whether marked confidential or not, may be released. The Department will accept no additional restrictions on the release of information contained in your bid.

11. REPRESENTATION REGARDING GRATUITIES

The bidder, offeror, or the Contractor represents that it has not violated, is not violating, and promises that it will not violate the prohibition against gratuities set forth in Section 6-204 (Gratuities) of the *Mississippi Public Procurement Review Board Office of Personal Service Contract Review Rules and Regulations*.

12. PROHIBITION AGAINST CONTINGENT FEES

It shall be a breach of ethical standards for a person to be retained, or to retain a person, to solicit or secure a state contract upon an agreement or understanding for a commission, percentage, company age, or contingent fee, unless such an arrangement is fully disclosed in writing.

By submitting a bid, the Company agrees to maintain transparency of all work performed on behalf of the Department to include all revenue streams to the company from said work. Company also agrees to provide the Department with documentation of all of its marketing efforts by means of both a summary of quotes and options as well as a copy of actual insurer quotes.

13. PROSPECTIVE CONTRACTOR’S REPRESENTATION REGARDING
CONTINGENT FEES

The prospective Contractor represents as a part of such Contractor’s bid or proposal that such Contractor ____ has or ____ has not retained any person or agency on a percentage, commission, or other contingent arrangement to secure this contract.

14. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF AMENDMENTS

Bidders shall acknowledge receipt of any amendment to the solicitation by signing and returning the amendment with the bid, by identifying the amendment number and date in the space provided for this purpose on the bid form, or by letter. The acknowledgement must be received by the DFA by the time and at the place specified for receipt of bids.

15. RIGHT TO CONSIDER HISTORICAL INFORMATION

The Department reserves the right to consider historical information, whether gained from the Bidder’s IFB response, question and answer conferences or any other source.

16. RIGHT TO REJECT AND/OR RE-BID

The Department specifically reserves the right to reject any or all bids received in response to this IFB or to reissue an IFB for the services requested.

17. CERTIFICATION OF INDEPENDENT PRICE DETERMINATION

The Bidder certifies that the prices submitted in response to the solicitation have been arrived at independently and without - for purpose of restricting competition - any consultation, communication or agreement with any other bidder or competitor relating to those prices, the intention to submit a bid, or the methods or factors used to calculate the bid prices.

18. E-PAYMENT

The Contractor agrees to accept all payments in United States currency via the State of Mississippi’s electronic payment and remittance vehicle. The DFA agrees to make payment in accordance with Mississippi law on “Timely Payments for Purchases by Public Bodies,” which generally provides for payment of undisputed amounts by the agency within forty-five (45) days of receipt of the invoice. Miss. Code Ann. § 31-7-301, *et seq.*, as amended.

19. E-VERIFICATION

If applicable, the Contractor represents and warrants that it will ensure its compliance with the Mississippi Employment Protection Act of 2008, and will register and participate in the status verification system for all newly hired employees. Miss. Code Ann. § 71-11-1, *et seq.* The term “employee” as used herein means any person that is hired to perform work within the State of Mississippi. As used herein, “status verification system” means the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigration Responsibility Act of 1996 that is operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security, also known as the E-Verify Program, or any other successor electronic verification system replacing the E-Verify Program. The Contractor agrees to maintain records of such compliance. Upon request of the State and approval of the Social Security Administration or Department of Homeland Security when required, the Contractor agrees to provide a copy of each such verification. The Contractor further represents and warrants that any person assigned to perform services hereafter meets the employment eligibility requirements of all immigration laws. The breach of this Agreement may subject the Contractor to the following:

- (1) termination of this Contract for services and ineligibility for any state or public contract in Mississippi for up to three (3) years, with notice of such cancellation/termination being made public;
- (2) the loss of any license, permit, certification or other document granted to the Contractor by an agency, department or governmental entity for the right to do business in Mississippi for up to one (1) year; or, both
- (3) In the event of such cancellation/termination, the Contractor would also be liable for any additional costs incurred by the State due to the Contract cancellation or loss of license or permit to do business in the State.

20. PAYMODE

Payments by state agencies using the State’s accounting system shall be made and remittance information provided electronically as directed by the State. These payments shall be deposited into the bank account of the Contractor’s choice. The State, may, at its sole discretion, require the Contractor to electronically submit invoices and supporting documentation at any time during the term of this Agreement. The Contractor understands and agrees that the State is exempt from the payment of taxes. All payments shall be in United States currency.

21. TRANSPARENCY

This Contract, including any accompanying exhibits, attachments, and appendices, is subject to the “Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983,” and its exceptions. See Mississippi Code Annotated §§ 25-61-1 *et seq.* and Mississippi Code Annotated § 79-23-1. In addition,

this Contract is subject to provisions of the Mississippi Accountability and Transparency Act of 2008. Mississippi Code Annotated §§ 27-104-151 *et seq.* Unless exempted from disclosure due to a court-issued protective order, a copy of this executed contract is required to be posted to the Department of Finance and Administration's independent agency contract website for public access at <http://www.transparency.mississippi.gov>. Information identified by Contractor as trade secrets, or other proprietary information, including confidential vendor information or any other information which is required confidential by state or federal law or outside the applicable freedom of information statutes, will be redacted.

22. TRADE SECRETS, COMMERCIAL AND FINANCIAL INFORMATION

It is expressly understood that Mississippi law requires that the provisions of this Contract which contain the commodities purchased or the personal or professional services provided, the price to be paid, and the term of the Contract shall not be deemed to be a trade secret or confidential commercial or financial information and shall be available for examination, copying, or reproduction.

23. RIGHT OF NEGOTIATION

The Department reserves the right to further clarify with the "Bidder evaluated best" following completion of the evaluation of IFB responses but prior to contract execution, if deemed necessary by the Department. The Department also reserves the right to move to the next best Bidder if negotiations do not lead to a final contract with the best Bidder.

24. LATE BIDS, LATE WITHDRAWALS, AND LATE MODIFICATIONS

Any bid, withdrawal, or modification received after the established due date is late. Established due date is either the time and date announced for receipt of bids or receipt of modifications to bids, if any, or if discussions have begun, it is the time and date by which best and final offers must be submitted, provided that only Bidders who submitted timely bids may submit best and final offers.

25. ANTI-ASSIGNMENT/SUBCONTRACTING The Contractor acknowledges that it was selected by the State to perform the services required hereunder based, in part, upon the Contractor's special skills and expertise. The Contractor shall not assign, subcontract or otherwise transfer this Agreement, in whole or in part, without the prior written consent of the DFA, which the DFA may, in its sole discretion, approve or deny without reason. Any attempted assignment or transfer of its obligations, without said consent, shall be null and void. No such approval by the DFA of any subcontract shall be deemed in any way to provide for the incurrence of any obligation of the DFA in addition to the total fixed price agreed upon in this Agreement. Subcontracts shall be subject to the terms and

conditions of this Agreement and to any conditions of approval that the State may deem necessary. Subject to the foregoing, this Agreement shall be binding upon the respective successors and assigns of the parties.

26. POST-AWARD VENDOR DEBRIEFING

A vendor, successful or unsuccessful, may request a post-award vendor debriefing, in writing, by U.S. mail or electronic submission, to be received by the DFA within three (3) business days of notification of the contract award. A vendor debriefing is a meeting and not a hearing; therefore, legal representation is not required. If a vendor prefers to have legal representation present, the vendor must notify the DFA and identify its attorney. The DFA shall be allowed to schedule and/or suspend and reschedule the meeting at a time when a representative of the Office of the Mississippi Attorney General can be present.

27. ACCESS TO RECORDS/CONFIDENTIALITY

The Company recognizes that during the course of this IFB process, it may have access to certain confidential and proprietary information pertaining to the business of the Department and its employees. By submission of a IFB response, the Bidder agrees that all confidential and proprietary information reviewed and collected in connection with this IFB process shall be held in strict confidence and shall not be released, disclosed or published by the Company without the written consent of the Department, or as required by law. Except as may otherwise be required by law, the Company may not release any information or reports relative to the Department, without a prior written authorization by the Department. The Company agrees that it will not, at any time, directly or indirectly disclose such confidential or proprietary information to any other person or organization for any purpose except as may be required by law or as reasonable related to the services being provided by the Company pursuant to this IFB, without the express, written approval of the Department.

28. MARKET CONTACT/BLOCK

This IFB is NOT an authorization for companies to contact any insurance markets on behalf of the Department. Accordingly, NO company or other firm is authorized to block any insurance market for any current or proposed insurance coverage for the Department.

29. BID EVALUATION

The evaluation shall be based on the evaluation factors set forth in this IFB. Factors not specified in this IFB shall not be considered.

Companies whose IFB responses are received by the deadline, and meet the minimum Company requirements will be evaluated further. All stated Terms and Conditions of the IFB must be fully agreeable for the Bidder. The minimum factors below, as fully described and demonstrated in the Bidder responses will serve as the means of consideration and decision-making of the responses. Consensus scoring will be used in the evaluation process. Consensus scoring involves a solidarity or general agreement of opinion among evaluators, based on information and data contained in the IFB responses. Consistent weighted scoring as well as consensus scoring of the IFB response will be utilized in these factors.

EVALUATION FACTORS

The following factor shall be considered in conducting the evaluation. The minimum factors are:

- a. Price; the competitiveness of the proposed company compensation, based on the first four years total fee (100 percent).

MINIMUM COMPANY REQUIREMENTS

The following IFB response requirements are desired. Failure to meet any of these IFB response requirements may result in the disqualification of the IFB response submitted by your organization. Respond by restating each Company qualification and document how your organization meets these minimum criteria. Please be specific in your responses regarding the number of years and type of experience your firm and the primary contact possess.

1. Company should provide commercial property valuation and/or appraisal services to at least one large client with property structures similar to the State of Mississippi. Provide the client name, address, contact, title, phone number, fax number, email address and number of years the services have been rendered by your organization.
2. Company must be appropriately licensed and/or have legal authority to render the proposed services. Provide a copy of pertinent license, certificate of appointment or other such documentation to demonstrate qualifications.
3. Company must be an independent entity, with no real or perceived conflict of interest with regard to its relationship with the Department.

Please check the DFA website before submitting your IFB to insure that you have seen all amendments, signed all acknowledgements, and submitted all acknowledgements with your IFB package.

PERSONAL SERVICE CONTRACT

This Personal Service Contract is made by and between the Department of Finance and Administration, a state agency, (the "DFA") whose address is 501 North West Street, Suite 1301 Woolfolk Building, Jackson, Mississippi 39201 and _____, (the "Contractor") whose address is _____ on the _____ day of _____, 20____, under the following terms and conditions:

1. **Scope of Services:** *(Insert the scope of services to be performed by Contractor)*

The Contractor will provide services as specified in the *(Request for Proposal, Invitation for Bid, etc...)* (hereinafter referred to and attached as Exhibit "A"), and the *(Proposal Bid, etc...)* by the Contractor dated *(insert date)* (hereinafter referred to and attached as Exhibit "B").
2. **Contract Term:** *(May be entered into for a period of time, not to exceed four (4) years, with an option to renew for one (1) year.)*
3. **Consideration:** *(Insert payment amount, schedule of payments, etc...)*
4. **E-Payment:** The Contractor agrees to accept all payments in United States currency via the State of Mississippi's electronic payment and remittance vehicle. The DFA agrees to make payment in accordance with Mississippi law on "Timely Payments for Purchases by Public Bodies," which generally provides for payment of undisputed amounts by the agency within forty-five (45) days of receipt of the invoice. Miss. Code Ann. § 31-7-301, et seq., as amended.
5. **Paymode:** Payments by state agencies using the State's accounting system shall be made and remittance information provided electronically as directed by the State. These payments shall be deposited into the bank account of the Contractor's choice. The State, may at its sole discretion, require the Contractor to electronically submit invoices and supporting documentation at any time during the term of this Agreement. The Contractor understands and agrees that the State is exempt from the payment of taxes. All payments shall be in United States currency.
6. **Availability of Funds:** It is expressly understood and agreed that the obligation of the DFA to proceed under this Agreement is conditioned upon the appropriation of funds by the Mississippi State Legislature and the receipt of

state and/or federal funds. If the funds anticipated for the continuing fulfillment of the Agreement are, at any time, not forthcoming or insufficient, either through the failure of the federal government to provide funds or of the State of Mississippi to appropriate funds or the discontinuance or material alteration of the program under which funds were provided or if funds are not otherwise available to the DFA, the DFA shall have the right upon ten (10) working days written notice to the Contractor, to terminate this Agreement without damage, penalty, cost or expenses to the DFA of any kind whatsoever. The effective date of termination shall be as specified in the notice of termination.

7. **Record Retention and Access to Records:** Provided the Contractor is given reasonable advance written notice and such inspection is made during normal business hours of the Contractor, the DFA or any duly authorized representatives shall have unimpeded, prompt access to any of the Contractor's books, documents, papers, and/or records which are maintained or produced as a result of the project for the purpose of making audits, examinations, excerpts, and transcriptions. All records related to this Agreement shall be retained by the Contractor for a period of three (3) years after final payment is made under this Agreement and all pending matters are closed; however, if any audit, litigation or other action arising out of or related in any way to this project is commenced before the end of the three (3) year period, the records shall be retained for one (1) year after all issues arising out of the action are finally resolved or until the end of the three (3) year period, whichever is later.
8. **Applicable Law:** The Contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Mississippi, excluding its conflicts of laws, provisions, and any litigation with respect thereto shall be brought in the courts of said State. The Contractor shall comply with applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.
9. **Anti-Assignment/Subcontracting:** The Contractor acknowledges that it was selected by the State to perform the services required hereunder based, in part, upon the Contractor's special skills and expertise. The Contractor shall not assign, subcontract or otherwise transfer this Agreement, in whole or in part, without the prior written consent of the DFA, which the DFA may, in its sole discretion, approve or deny without reason. Any attempted assignment or transfer of its obligations, without said consent, shall be null and void. No such approval by the DFA of any subcontract shall be deemed in any way to provide for the incurrence of any obligation of the DFA in addition to the total fixed price agreed upon in this Agreement. Subcontracts shall be subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement and to any conditions of approval that the State may

deem necessary. Subject to the foregoing, this Agreement shall be binding upon the respective successors and assigns of the parties.

10. **Compliance with Laws:** The Contractor understands that the DFA is an equal opportunity employer and therefore maintains a policy which prohibits unlawful discrimination based on race, color, creed, sex, age, national origin, physical handicap, disability, genetic information, or any other consideration made unlawful by federal, state, or local laws. All such discrimination is unlawful and the Contractor agrees during the term of the Agreement that the Contractor will strictly adhere to this policy in its employment practices and provision of services. The Contractor shall comply with, and all activities under this Agreement shall be subject to, all applicable federal, State of Mississippi, and local laws and regulations, as now existing and as may be amended or modified.
11. **Transparency:** This Contract, including any accompanying exhibits, attachments, and appendices, is subject to the “Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983,” and its exceptions. See Miss. Code Ann. §§ 25-61-1 *et seq.* and Miss. Code Ann. § 79-23-1. In addition, this Contract is subject to provisions of the Mississippi Accountability and Transparency Act of 2008. Miss. Code Ann. §§ 27-104-151 *et seq.* Unless exempted from disclosure due to a court-issued protective order, a copy of this executed Contract is required to be posted to the Department of Finance and Administration’s independent agency contract website for public access at <http://www.transparency.mississippi.gov>. Information identified by the Contractor as trade secrets, or other proprietary information, including confidential vendor information or any other information which is required confidential by state or federal law or outside the applicable freedom of information statutes, will be redacted.
12. **E-Verification:** If applicable, the Contractor represents and warrants that it will ensure its compliance with the Mississippi Employment Protection Act of 2008, and will register and participate in the status verification system for all newly hired employees. Miss. Code Ann. § 71-11-1, *et seq.* The term “employee” as used herein means any person that is hired to perform work within the State of Mississippi. As used herein, “status verification system” means the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigration Responsibility Act of 1996 that is operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security, also known as the E-Verify Program, or any other successor electronic verification system replacing the E-Verify Program. The Contractor agrees to maintain records of such compliance. Upon request of the State and approval of the Social Security Administration or Department of Homeland Security when required, the Contractor agrees to provide a copy of each such verification. The Contractor further represents and warrants that any person assigned to perform services

hereafter meets the employment eligibility requirements of all immigration laws. The breach of this Agreement may subject the Contractor to the following:

- (1) termination of this Contract for services and ineligibility for any state or public contract in Mississippi for up to three (3) years, with notice of such cancellation/termination being made public;
- (2) the loss of any license, permit, certification or other document granted to the Contractor by an agency, department or governmental entity for the right to do business in Mississippi for up to one (1) year; or, both
- (3) In the event of such cancellation/termination, the Contractor would also be liable for any additional costs incurred by the State due to the Contract cancellation or loss of license or permit to do business in the State.

13. **Independent Contractor Status:** Contractor shall, at all times, be regarded as and shall be legally considered an independent contractor and shall at no time act as an agent for the State. Nothing contained herein shall be deemed or construed by the State, Contractor, or any third party as creating the relationship of principal and agent, master and servant, partners, joint ventures, employer and employee, or any similar such relationship between the State and Contractor. Neither the method of computation of fees or other charges, nor any other provision contained herein, nor any acts of the State or Contractor hereunder creates, or shall be deemed to create a relationship other than the independent relationship of the State and Contractor. Contractor's personnel shall not be deemed in any way, directly or indirectly, expressly or by implication, to be employees of the State. No act performed or representation made, whether oral or written, by the Contractor with respect to third parties shall be binding on the DFA. Neither Contractor nor its employees shall, under any circumstances, be considered servants, agents, or employees of the DFA, and the DFA shall be at no time legally responsible for any negligence or other wrongdoing by Contractor, its servants, agents, or employees. The DFA shall not withhold from the contract payments to Contractor any federal or state unemployment taxes, federal or state income taxes, Social Security tax, or any other amounts for benefits to Contractor. Further, the DFA shall not provide to Contractor any insurance coverage or other benefits, including Worker's Compensation, normally provided by the State for its employees.

14. **Modification or Renegotiation:** This agreement may be modified only by written agreement signed by the parties hereto. The parties agree to renegotiate the Agreement if federal and/or the State revisions of any applicable laws or regulations make changes in this Agreement necessary.

15. **Procurement Regulations:** The Contract shall be governed by the applicable provisions of the *Mississippi Public Procurement Review Board Office of Personal Service Contract Review Rules and Regulations*, a copy of which is available at 501 North West Street, Suit 701E, Jackson, Mississippi 39201, for inspection or downloadable at <http://www.DFA.ms.gov>.
16. **Representation Regarding Contingent Fees:** The Contractor represents that it has not retained a person to solicit or secure a DFA contract upon an agreement or understanding for a commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fee, except as disclosed in the Contractor's bid, proposal or qualifications.
17. **Representation Regarding Gratuities:** The Bidder, Offeror, or the Contractor represents that it has not violated, is not violating, and promises that it will not violate the prohibition against gratuities set forth in Section 6-204 (Gratuities) of the *Mississippi Public Procurement Review Board Office of Personal Service Contract Review Rules and Regulations*.
18. **Termination for Convenience:**
- (1) Termination. The DFA may, when the interests of the DFA so require, terminate this Contract in whole or in part, for the convenience of the DFA. The DFA shall give written notification of the termination to the Contractor specifying the part of the Contract terminated and when the termination becomes effective.
 - (2) Contractor's Obligations. The Contractor shall incur no further obligations in connection with the terminated work and on the date set in the notice of termination the Contractor will stop work to the extent specified. The Contractor shall also terminate outstanding orders and subcontracts as they relate to the terminated work. The Contractor shall settle the liabilities and claims arising out of the termination of subcontracts and orders connected with the terminated work. The DFA may direct the Contractor to assign the Contractor's right, title, and interest under terminated orders or subcontracts to the DFA. The Contractor must still complete the work not terminated by the notice of termination and may incur obligations as are necessary to do so.
19. **Termination for Default:**
- (1) *Default.* If the Contractor refuses or fails to perform any of the provisions of this Contract with such diligence as will ensure its completion within the time specified in this contract, or any extension thereof, or otherwise fails to timely satisfy the Contract provisions, or commits any other substantial
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breach of this Contract, the DFA may notify the Contractor in writing of the delay or nonperformance and if not cured in ten (10) days or any longer time specified in writing by the DFA, the DFA may terminate the Contractor's right to proceed with the Contract or such part of the Contract as to which there has been delay or failure to properly perform. In the event of termination in whole or in part, the DFA may procure similar supplies or services in a manner and upon terms deemed appropriate by the DFA. The Contractor shall continue performance of the Contract to the extent it is not terminated and shall be liable for excess costs incurred in procuring similar goods or services.

- (2) *Contractor's Duties.* Notwithstanding termination of the Contract and subject to any directions from the Chief Procurement Officer, the Contractor shall take timely, reasonable, and necessary action to protect and preserve property in the possession of the Contractor in which the DFA has an interest.
- (3) *Compensation.* Payment for completed services delivered and accepted by the DFA shall be at the contract price. The DFA may withhold from amounts due the Contractor such sums as the DFA deems to be necessary to protect the DFA against loss because of outstanding liens or claims of former lien holders and to reimburse the DFA for the excess costs incurred in procuring similar goods and services.
- (4) *Excuse for Nonperformance or Delayed Performance.* Except with respect to defaults of subcontractors, the Contractor shall not be in default by reason of any failure in performance of this Contract in accordance with its terms (including any failure by the Contractor to make progress in the prosecution of the work hereunder which endangers such performance) if the Contractor has notified the DFA within fifteen (15) days after the cause of the delay and the failure arises out of causes such as: acts of God; acts of the public enemy; acts of the State and any other governmental entity in its sovereign or contractual capacity; fires; floods; epidemics; quarantine restrictions; strikes or other labor disputes; freight embargoes; or unusually severe weather. If the failure to perform is caused by the failure of a subcontractor to perform or make progress, and if such failure arises out of causes similar to those set forth above, the Contractor shall not be deemed to be in default, unless the services to be furnished by the subcontractor were reasonably obtainable from other sources in sufficient time to permit the Contractor to meet the Contract requirements. Upon request of the Contractor, the DFA shall ascertain the facts and extent of such failure, and, if DFA determines that any failure to perform was

occasioned by any one or more of the excusable causes, and that, but for the excusable cause, the Contractor's progress and performance would have met the terms of the Contract, the delivery schedule shall be revised accordingly, subject to the rights of the DFA under the clause entitled (in fixed-price contracts, "Termination for Convenience," in cost-reimbursement contracts, "Termination"). (As used in this Paragraph of this clause, the term "subcontractor" means subcontractor at any tier).

- (5) *Erroneous Termination for Default.* If, after notice of termination of the Contractor's right to proceed under the provisions of this clause, it is determined for any reason that the Contract was not in default under the provisions of this clause, or that the delay was excusable under the provisions of Paragraph (4) (Excuse for Nonperformance or Delayed Performance) of this clause, the rights and obligations of the parties shall, if the Contract contains a clause providing for termination for convenience of the DFA, be the same as if the notice of termination had been issued pursuant to such clause.
- (6) *Additional Rights and Remedies.* The rights and remedies provided in this clause are in addition to any other rights and remedies provided by law or under this contract.

20. **Stop Work Order:**

- (1) *Order to stop work.* The Chief Procurement Officer, may by written order to the Contractor at any time, and without notice to any surety, require the Contractor to stop all or any part of the work called for by this Contract. This order shall be for a specified period not exceeding ninety (90) days after the order is delivered to the Contractor, unless the parties agree to any further period. Any such order shall be identified specifically as a stop work order issued pursuant to this clause. Upon receipt of such an order, the Contractor shall forthwith comply with its terms and take all reasonable steps to minimize the occurrence of costs allocable to work covered by the order during the period of work stoppage. Before the stop work order expires, or within any further period to which the parties shall have agreed, the Chief Procurement Officer shall either:
- (b) cancel the stop work order; or,
- (b) terminate the work covered by such order as provided in the "Termination for Default" clause or the "Termination for Convenience" clause of this Contract.

- (2) *Cancellation or Expiration of the Order.* If a stop work order issued under this clause is cancelled at any time during the period specified in the order, or if the period of the order or any extension thereof expires, the Contractor shall have the right to resume work. An appropriate adjustment shall be made in the delivery schedule or the Contractor price, or both, and the Contract shall be modified in writing accordingly, if:
- (b) the stop work order results in an increase in the time required for, or in the Contractor's cost properly allocable to, the performance of any part of this Contract; and,
 - (b) the Contractor asserts a claim for such an adjustment within thirty (30) days after the end of the period of work stoppage; provided that, if the Chief Procurement Officer decides that the facts justify such action, any such claim asserted may be received and acted upon at any time prior to final payment under this Contract.
- (3) *Termination of Stopped Work.* If a stop work order is not cancelled and the work covered by such order is terminated for default or convenience, the reasonable costs resulting from the stop work order shall be allowed by adjustment or otherwise.
- (4) *Adjustments of Price.* Any adjustment in contract price made pursuant to this clause shall be determined in accordance with the "Price Adjustment" clause of this Contract.

21. **Price Adjustment:**

- (1) *Price Adjustment Methods.* Any adjustment in contract price, pursuant to a clause in this Contract, shall be made in one or more of the following ways:
- (a) by agreement on a fixed price adjustment before commencement of the additional performance;
 - (b) by unit prices specified in the contract;
 - (c) by the costs attributable to the event or situation covered by the clause, plus appropriate profit or fee, all as specified in the Contract; or,
 - (d) by the price escalation clause.

- (2) *Submission of Cost or Pricing Data.* The Contractor shall provide cost or pricing data for any price adjustments subject to the provisions of Section 3-403 (Cost or Pricing Data) of the *Mississippi Public Procurement Review Board Office of Personal Service Contract Review Rules and Regulations*.

22. **Oral Statements:** No oral statement of any person shall modify or otherwise affect the terms, conditions, or specifications stated in this Contract. All modifications to the Contract must be made in writing by the DFA and agreed to by the Contractor.
23. **Ownership of Documents and Work Papers:** The DFA shall own all documents, files, reports, work papers and working documentation, electronic or otherwise, created in connection with the Project, which is the subject of this Agreement, except for the Contractor's internal administrative and quality assurance files and internal project correspondence. The Contractor shall deliver such documents and work papers to the DFA upon termination or completion of the Agreement. The foregoing notwithstanding, the Contractor shall be entitled to retain a set of such work papers for its files. The Contractor shall be entitled to use such work papers only after receiving written permission from the DFA and subject to any copyright protections.
24. **Indemnification:** To the fullest extent allowed by law, the Contractor shall indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless, protect, and exonerate the DFA, its Commissioners, Board Members, officers, employees, agents, and representatives, and the State of Mississippi from and against all claims, demands, liabilities, suits, actions, damages, losses, and costs of every kind and nature whatsoever, including, without limitation, court costs, investigative fees and expenses, and attorneys' fees, arising out of or caused by the Contractor and/or its partners, principals, agents, employees, and/or subcontractors in the performance of or failure to perform this Agreement. In the State's sole discretion, the Contractor may be allowed to control the defense of any such claim, suit, etc. In the event the Contractor defends said claim, suit, etc., the Contractor shall use legal counsel acceptable to the State. The Contractor shall be solely responsible for all costs and/or expenses associated with such defense and the State shall be entitled to participate in said defense. The Contractor shall not settle any claim, suit, etc., without the State's concurrence, which the State shall not unreasonably withhold.
25. **Third-Party Action Notification:** The Contractor shall give the DFA prompt notice in writing of any action or suit filed, and prompt notice of any claim made against the Contractor by any entity that may result in litigation related in any way to this Agreement.

26. **Notices:** All notices required or permitted to be given under this Agreement must be in writing and personally delivered or sent by certified United States mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, to the party to whom the notice should be given at the address set forth below. Notice shall be deemed given when actually received or when refused. The parties agree to promptly notify each other in writing of any change of address.

27. **Approval:** It is understood that if this Contract requires approval by the Public Procurement Review Board and/or the Mississippi Department of Finance and Administration Office of Personal Service Contract Review and this Contract is not approved by the PPRB and/or OPSCR, it is void and no payment shall be made hereunder.

28. **Priority:** The Contract consists of this Agreement, the request for proposal *[number]* (hereinafter "RFP" and attached as Schedule []), and the response proposal by *[Contractor]* dated *[date]* (hereinafter "Proposal" and attached as Schedule []). Any ambiguities, conflicts or questions of interpretation of this Contract shall be resolved by first, reference to this Agreement and, if still unresolved, by reference to the RFP and, if still unresolved, by reference to the proposal. Omission of any term or obligation from this Agreement or attached Schedules [] or [] shall not be deemed an omission from this Contract if such term or obligation is provided for elsewhere in this contract.

29. **Change in Scope of Work:** The DFA may order changes in the work consisting of additions, deletions, or other revisions within the general scope of the Contract. No claims may be made by the Contractor that the scope of the project or of the Contractor's services has been changed, requiring changes to the amount of compensation to the Contractor or other adjustments to the Contract, unless such changes or adjustments have been made by written amendment to the Contract signed by the DFA and the Contractor.

If the Contractor believes that any particular work is not within the scope of the project, is a material change, or will otherwise require more compensation to the Contractor, the Contractor must immediately notify the DFA in writing of this

belief. If the DFA believes that the particular work is within the scope of the Contract as written, the Contractor will be ordered to and shall continue with the work as changed and at the cost stated for the work within the Contract.

30. **Contractor Personnel:** The DFA shall, throughout the life of the contract, have the right of reasonable rejection and approval of staff or subcontractors assigned to the work by the Contractor. If the DFA reasonably rejects staff or subcontractors, the Contractor must provide replacement staff or subcontractors satisfactory to the DFA in a timely manner and at no additional cost to the DFA. The day-to-day supervision and control of the Contractor's employees and subcontractors is the sole responsibility of the Contractor.

31. **Recovery of Money:** Whenever, under the contract, any sum of money shall be recoverable from or payable by the Contractor to the DFA, the same amount may be deducted from any sum due to the Contractor under the Contract or under any other contract between the Contractor and the DFA. The rights of the DFA are in addition and without prejudice to any other right the DFA may have to claim the amount of any loss or damage suffered by the DFA on account of the acts or omissions of the Contractor.

32. **Failure to Enforce:** Failure by the DFA at any time to enforce the provisions of the Contract shall not be construed as a waiver of any such provisions. Such failure to enforce shall not affect the validity of the Contract or any part thereof or the right of the DFA to enforce any provision at any time in accordance with its terms.

33. **Trade Secrets, Commercial and Financial Information:** It is expressly understood that Mississippi law requires that the provisions of this Contract which contain the commodities purchased or the personal or professional services provided, the price to be paid, and the term of the Contract shall not be deemed to be a trade secret or confidential commercial or financial information and shall be available for examination, copying, or reproduction.

34. **Termination Upon Bankruptcy:** This Contract may be terminated in whole or in part by the DFA upon written notice to the Contractor, if the Contractor should become the subject of bankruptcy or receivership proceedings, whether voluntary or involuntary, or upon the execution by the Contractor of an assignment for the benefit of its creditors. In the event of such termination, the Contractor shall be entitled to recover just and equitable compensation for satisfactory work performed under this Contract, but in no case shall said compensation exceed the total contract price.

35. **Confidentiality:** Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary contained herein, it is recognized that DFA is a public agency of the State of Mississippi and is subject to the Mississippi Public Records Act. Mississippi Code Annotated §§ 25-61-1 *et seq.* If a public records request is made for any information provided to the DFA pursuant to the agreement and designated by the Contractor in writing as trade secrets or other proprietary confidential information, the DFA shall follow the provisions of Mississippi Code Annotated §§ 25-61-9 and 79-23-1 before disclosing such information. The DFA shall not be liable to the Contractor for disclosure of information required by court order or required by law.
