Woodrow Wilson Avenue, Jackson, Mississippi. This project shall be constructed in accordance with the latest edition of the Mississippi Standard Specifications for State Aid Road and Bridge Construction.

PLANS AND PROPOSALS may be secured from Kyle Strong, LSBP Engineer for Monroe County, Mississippi, at www.cceplanroom.com. The Cost is fifty dollars (\$50.00) for plans and fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the proposal, non-refundable. PLANS AND PROPOSALS may also be downloaded electronically for an additional \$25 fee by Bidders for electronic bidding purposes only. Certified check or bid bond for five percent (5%) of the total bid, made payable to Monroe County and the State of Mississippi must accompany each proposal. For bidders submitting bids electronically, the bond submitted must be either a bond issued by the Surety in electronic format or the original hard copy of the bid bond must be submitted to the Monroe County Board of Supervisors, 201 W Commerce Street, Aberdeen, MS prior to the bid opening in order for the bid to be valid.

The entire PROPOSAL is required to be turned in for both paper and electronic bid submission.

Bids will be accepted only under the name of the Bidder to whom PLANS AND PROPOSALS have been issued by the County Engineer, and whose name appears on the official list of Planholders maintained by the County Engineer.
