Woodrow Wilson Avenue, Jackson, Mississippi. This project shall be constructed in accordance with the latest edition of the Mississippi Standard Specifications for State Aid Road and Bridge Construction.

The Cost is fifty dollars (\$50.00) for plans and fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the proposal, non-refundable. Certified check or bid bond for five percent (5%) of the total bid, made payable to Prentiss County and the State of Mississippi must accompany each proposal. Main Street, Booneville, MS 38829 prior to the bid opening in order for the bid to be valid.
