

PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD Office of Emergency Planning and Response

Request For Proposals (RFP) RFx# 3120002490 COVID-19 After Action Reports/Improvement Plans

The Mississippi State Department of Health (MSDH) solicited proposals to hire a contractor to prepare two (2) comprehensive COVID-19 Response After Action Reports (AAR) and Improvement Plans (IP) which meet National Incident Management System (NIMS) and federal Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) guidelines. The AARs/IPs are intended to assist MSDH and the State of Mississippi (State) in identifying ways to improve their Pandemic Emergency Response and Emergency Operations Center operations.

MSDH will enter into a firm fixed price agreement. The initial period of performance of the contract will be one year, tentatively scheduled to begin on or about November 2, 2022, upon approval of the Public Procurement Review Board (PPRB) and to end on November 1, 2023. The Agency reserves the right to renew the Contract for up to one (1) additional year at its sole discretion.
