It is understood that all proposals are submitted on the basis of complying with the provisions, terms and specifications set out herein, and in the proposal forms PROVIDED THAT YOU CAN DO SO UNDER THE VARIOUS GOVERNMENT RULINGS AND DIRECTIVES NOW IN EFFECT OR WHICH MAY BE ISSUED DURING THE PERIOD OF CONTRACT. In the event you bid on furnishing any materials which are prohibited from being manufactured by a Government ruling or directive and are awarded such materials, you will not be required to make such shipment of said prohibited materials so long as Government directive is in effect. The bidder understands that MDOT is an equal opportunity employer and therefore maintains a policy which prohibits unlawful discrimination based on race, color, creed, sex, age, national origin, physical handicap, disability, or any other consideration and the bidder agrees during the term of the agreement that the bidder will strictly adhere to this policy in its employment practices and provision of services.

#### 6.2 IMMIGRANT STATUS CERTIFICATION

The bidder represents and warrants that it will ensure its compliance with the Mississippi Employment Protection Act, Section 71-11-1, et seq. of the Mississippi Code Annotated (Supplement 2008), and will register and participate in the status verification system for all newly hired employees. The contract extension shall begin on the original termination date or the extension termination date

#### 8.4 CANCELLATION OF AGENCY CONTRACT

Any contract or item award may be canceled with or without cause by the MTC upon 30 days written notice of intent to cancel.
