PLEASE PROVIDE A DETAILED EXPLANATION WHY A REVERSE AUCTION IS NOT IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE STATE: Rock Salt is used by MDOT road maintenance crews at various locations throughout the state for ice removal on bridge deck surfaces and roadways. The availability of the commodity and the location of	
the work must be known to determine the lowest cost. Availability of rock salt is an important determinant due to the unpredictability of severe weather events, the criticality of a timely application	
to roads and bridges so that they remain open and passable during severe weather events, and availability issues generated by high demand from other cities and counties throughout Mississippi and	
neighboring states dealing with the same severe weather event. Because we award to all and make determination at time of purchase, there is no feasible way to accomplish this using reverse auction.	
PLEASE PROVIDE AN ALTERNATIVE PROCESS TO SOLICIT BIDS THAT PROMOTES OPEN COMPETITION: The competitive sealed bid process should be utilized to procure rock salt and is in the best interest of the state.
