The freestanding, open-ended design allows for circulation and connection, and the ability to transform the space over time. A variety of surface materials and interactive elements bring a sense of play. Crossbeams 64"-288"W in 2" increments; headers 32"-96"W; 4" x 4" columns for L, T, and X connections; fins 24" (fixed only), 30", 36", and 42"W, fixed or pivot; drapery tracks for crossbeams.


