UMMC Campus Police seeks to purchase Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training (ALERRT) Level 1 Kit Cases from KDL Solutions. These are active shooter training kits designed to prepare officers to isolate, distract, and neutralize an active shooter.

2. An explanation of why the commodity is the only one that can meet the needs of UMMC.

ALERRT training was developed by Texas State University, and is recognized and adopted as national standard training for the response to mass casualty incidents by the US Department of Justice, US Department of Homeland Security and are administered throughout all levels of law enforcement.
