### **Project Details**

### 1. Describe the commodity/service that the agency/institution is seeking to procure:

The service will provide seats for registered nurses to complete Periop 101. Periop 101: A Core Curriculum is designed to provide registered nurses who have no previous experience with the basic knowledge and clinical skills necessary to function independently in an entry- level perioperative nursing position. At the completion of this course, it is expected that the nurse will be able to practice independently at the beginning level in a perioperative position. *Periop 101: A Core CurriculumTM* (Periop 101) is a sole source online product, developed, sold, and licensed by the Association of periOperative Registered Nurses (AORN).

## 2. Explain why the commodity/service is the only one (1) that can meet the needs of the agency/institution:

AORN is the national professional association for perioperative registered nurses and is the leader in perioperative nursing education for nurses in hospitals and ambulatory surgery centers. There are no like, comprehensive products based on AORN's proprietary *Guidelines for Perioperative Practice* that would serve to educate perioperative nurses working in operating rooms.

### 3. Explain why the source is the only person or entity that can provide the required commodity/service:

The Association of Perioperative Registered Nurses (AORN) is the only developer and distributor of AORN Periop 101: A Core Curriculum.

### 4. Explain why the amount to be expended for the commodity/service is reasonable:
