- 1. Description of the commodity that USM is seeking to procure:
  - The University of Southern Mississippi is requesting purchase of a Lunar IDXA2 MTY DEXA System to replace the existing Lunar IDXA2 machine (USM#0237424: reallocated for use in a different location on campus to fulfill the needs of the funding agency). USM#0237424 was purchased in 2020 via a successful sole source request as it served to replace the legacy PRODIGY 8743 X-Ray Tube, USM#186971 (machine at end-of-use life and is no longer supported for mechanical breakdowns), that was housed in the School of Kinesiology & Nutrition Dexa Laboratory.
- 2. Explanation of why the commodity is the only one that meets the needs of the agency: The requested system (Lunar IDXA2 MTY DEXA ) is compatible with data collected on both previous machines (see above). Using corresponding GE Software, the School of Kinesiology & Nutrition has archived data collected from November 2022 through August 2020 (data collected with USM#0237424) and January 2003 through December 2019 on data collected using the legacy machine (PRODIGY USM#186971). It is imperative the School be able to maintain access to the legacy databases, and trust measures from a new system will be consistent to measures taken from both previous machines. The requested machine will allow for both access and manipulation of achieved data without requiring any bridging software or techniques as new data will be collected using the same innate GE software. Further, trustworthiness between systems to allow for direct longitudinal comparisons of research participants will be afforded.
