

# REQUEST FOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

## CITY OF BILOXI POLICE SUBSTATION

The City of Biloxi is seeking proposals from qualified architects for the Community Development Block Grant Community (CDBG) Program. The city intends to employ a consulting architectural firm to provide design services utilizing Cost plus Fixed Fee, Labor Hour/Unit Price or Lump Sum/Firm Fixed Price contract(s) to provide A&E design services to renovate an existing building at 356 Nichols Drive for a City of Biloxi Police Substation. Work may include but is not limited to parking lot striping to include ADA access; building layout to include new wall locations; an existing and proposed MEP plan; ramp for vehicle ingress/egress into the building. Consultant will be required to provide preliminary design with cost estimates; final design and preparation of construction drawings and specifications for bid; and complete construction inspection services.

Proposals must contain each of the required components:


- 1) **Qualifications** - Documentation reflecting the qualifications of each person who will be providing the service. **Maximum 40 Points**
- 2) **Experience** - Documentation regarding the experience of the firm's information regarding the experience of the firm projects during the last five years. This should include types of projects undertaken, including Community Development Block Grant Projects. **Maximum 40 Points**
- 3) **Capacity for Performance** - Description of the firm's work force including the number and title of staff available to provide requested services. **Maximum 20 Points**
