In compliance with Senate Bill 2179 (SB2179) from the 2016 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature, the Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services (ITS) is posting the following notice related to a technology procurement being conducted by the Mississippi Department of Human Services (MDHS) without involvement from ITS.

SB2179 exempts MDHS from ITS' purview for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019, and requires ITS to post on the ITS website and on the procurement portal website (via MAGIC-the state's Enterprise Resource Planning System) "the proposed action" by MDHS.

The Proposed Action: Issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the acquisition of services for nine professional services positions to assist with implementing a Comprehensive Child Welfare Information System (CCWIS) for the Mississippi Department of Child Protection Services.
