THOMAS STREET EXTENDED HIGHWAY 76 INTER- CHANGE RE-BID CITY OF TUPELO, MISSISSIPPI ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS (#1473DS)

Sealed bids for the construction of THOMAS STREET EXTENDED HIGHWAY 76 INTERCHANGE RE-BID will be received by the City of Tupelo, Mississippi at City Hall, 71 East Troy St., 1st Floor Purchasing Office, Attn: Missy Shelton, until 2:00 p.m., on May 18, 2017 and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

Contract Documents, including Drawings and Specifications, may be examined at the Tupelo City Hall.

Contract Documents, including Drawings and Specifications, may be examined at the office of Engineering Solutions, Inc., located at 1324 N. Veterans Blvd., Tupelo, Mississippi, and also can be viewed and/or purchased at Engineering Solutions, Inc. plan room at www.esiplans.com. Deposit is non-refundable.

This work consists of the construction of interchange ramps connecting Thomas Street to Highway 76, and overlay of approximately 1 mile of Thomas Street from Green Tee Road to Mitchell Road. This work shall include but is not limited to earthwork, base construction, paving, striping, and drainage.

Definite quantities to be bid are specified in the Contract Documents.

Each bid submitted must be marked on the outside "Bid for THOMAS STREET EXTENDED HIGHWAY 76 INTERCHANGE RE-BID - #1473DS". Any bid in excess of \$50,000 must contain on the outside of the envelope the contractor's current certificate of responsibility number, and no bid shall be opened or considered unless this number appears on the outside of the envelope or unless a statement is included on the outside of the envelope indicating that the bid enclosed does not exceed

\$50,000.

A satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an accepted Surety, a certified check, or bank draft payable to the City of Tupelo, Mississippi, on negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (at par value), shall be submitted with each bid in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid.

In the letting of public contracts, preference shall be given to resident contractors, and a nonresident bidder domiciled in a state having laws granting preference to local contractors shall be awarded Mississippi public contracts only on the same basis as the nonresident bidder's state awards contracts to Mississippi contractors bidding under similar circumstances; and resident contractors actually domiciled in Mississippi, be they corporate, individuals, or partnerships, are to be granted preference over nonresidents in awarding of contracts in the same manner and to the same extent as provided by the laws of the state of domicile of the nonresident. When a nonresident contractor submits a bid for a public project, he shall attach thereto a copy of his resident state's current law pertaining to such state's treatment of non-resident contractors.

Bids may be held up to 90 days from the date of opening for review of bids and qualifications of bidders prior to Contract award. The City of Tupelo, MS reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.
