MDOC shall have the option to renew this contract at one (1) year intervals for two years at the same terms and conditions. Contractor shall at all times be a contract worker rather than an agent, employee, or representative of MDOC. MDOC is responsible for paying the federally mandated employer contribution portion of the social security tax for the wages earned under this contract.
