Notice is hereby given that the Mississippi Soil and Water Conservation Commission will receive written sealed bids until the hour of 9:00 o'clock a. m. local time on Friday, September 1, 2017, at which time they will be publicly opened. Bids will be received by hand or by mail at the offices of the Mississippi Soil and Water Conservation Commission, 680 Monroe Street, Suite B, Jackson, MS 39202 for the replacement of the riser on Dam No. Y-17C-14 in the N. Tillatoba - Hunter Creek Watershed located in Tallahatchie County, Mississippi.

The project includes clearing, Class B, Sediment (Permanent) Pool and Site Area; protective cover; mobilization and demobilization; traffic control; removal of water; excavation, common; earthfill, class a; drainfill; reinforced concrete, class 4000; concrete, class 4000, pipe conduit bedding; steel reinforcement; reinforced concrete pressure pipe, 15" diameter; water control slide gate, 24' X 24" upward opening; trash rack, principal spillway; cast iron manhole cover and rim; and quality control .

Detailed construction specifications, drawings and site location are on file in the offices of the Mississippi Soil and Water Conservation Commission (601-354-7645). Copies of bid packets containing specifications, drawings, instructions to bidders, bid forms and required bond forms may be obtained during regular business hours at no charge.

A pre-bid conference for all interested bidders will be held on Monday, August 14, 2017. Interested bidders should meet at the Tallahatchie County Soil and Water Conservation District Office, located at 309 West Cypress Street, Charleston, Mississippi, at 10:30 a.m. that day.
