ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the construction of LONGVIEW GAS LINE EXTENSION will be received by the City of Pontotoc, Mississippi, 116 North Main Street, Pontotoc, MS 38863, until 10:00 a.m. on **December 11th, 2014** and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

Contract Documents, including Drawings and Specifications, may be examined at the office of Engineering Solutions, Inc., located at 100 West Reynolds St., Pontotoc, MS 38863. Copies of the Contract Documents may be obtained by depositing \$150.00 for each set received to Engineering Solutions, Inc. Deposit is non-refundable.

The work shall consist of: **Installation of approximately 41,000 feet of 2 inch polyethylene gas line and other associated items, such as services, service line, valves, etc.**

Each bid submitted must be marked on the outside "Bid for the LONGVIEW GAS LINE EXTENSION, PONTOTOC, MS". Any bid in excess of \$50,000 must contain on the outside of the envelope the contractor's current certificate of responsibility number, and no bid shall be opened or considered unless this number appears on the outside of the envelope or unless a statement is included on the outside of the envelope indicating that the bid enclosed does not exceed \$50,000.

A satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder or an accepted Surety, a certified check, or bank draft payable to the CITY OF PONTOTOC, on negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (at par value), shall be submitted with each bid in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid.

Bidders are directed to the contract requirement that not less than the minimum wages and salaries set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project, in accordance with the Davis-

Bacon and Related Acts. In addition, the Contractor must ensure that employment and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or natural origin.

Bids may be held up to 60 days from the date of opening for review of bids and qualifications of bidders prior to Contract award. The CITY OF PONTOTOC reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informality in the bidding.

This project is being funded in part by the Community Development Block Grant and is subject to the rules and regulations thereof.
