Sealed bids will be received by the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the City of Union, Mississippi at City Hall in Union, Mississippi until 10:00 a.m. on Friday the 16th day of June, 2017 and shortly thereafter opened and read aloud.

SEWER LAGOON IMPROVEMENTS

Principal items of work include approximately 100 linear feet of 8" SDR-26 PVC pipe; 3 new water moving aerators, 50 cubic yards of structural concrete, 250 tons of 610 crushed stone and other items to improve the sewer lagoon for the City of Union, Mississippi.

BASIS OF AWARD:

The award, if made, will be made to the lowest qualified bidder on the basis of unit prices and quantities in the contract documents. Actual work quantities performed shall be based on availability of local funds. The work to be done is generally as shown on the plans. The Mayor and Board of Alderman hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement all minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

SECTION 3 - HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1968:
