The work generally consists of milling of existing asphalt pavements, Hot Mix Asphalt Surface and Leveling Course (FAA Specification P-401), Pavement Markings (FAA Specification P-620), and Grooving of Asphalt Pavements (FAA Specification P-621) at the Stennis International Airport in Kiln, Mississippi.
