Project Details

1. Describe the commodity that the agency is seeking to procure:

The University of Mississippi Medical Center (UMMC) seeks to purchase 32 Alcohol Panels and two (2) Alcohol Panel Cassette Towers. The Alcohol Panels are custom designed assemblies that slide into the sides of the Non-Human Primate (NHP) Socialization Racks currently in use. There are electronic components including lights, feed hoppers, and liquid reservoirs that allow the animals to interact with the Alcohol Panels and allow consumption of various beverages and foods at certain times and intervals at the discretion and direction of the staff conducting the study. The Towers allow storage and mobility of the Alcohol Panels to and from the NHP Socialization Racks where they can be transferred into place and allows the staff to work on the Alcohol Panels when not in use. The Tower has four spots to hold Alcohol Panels, two spots for the upper cages and two spots for the lower cages. The Alcohol Panels can slide from the Tower to the NHP Socialization Rack and vice versa without having to lift the Panels. The panels and towers are proprietary to NHP Socialization Rack Caging Equipment currently used in UMMC Research that allow for vertical interaction between subjects and provide a safer environment for the researcher.

2. Explain why the commodity is the only one (1) that can meet the needs of the agency:

UMMC currently owns Socialization Rack Caging Equipment from Carter2 Systems that is used in research now in the Division of Neuroscience and Behavior in the Department of Psychiatry and Human Behavior that allow for vertical interaction between subjects and provide a safer environment for the researcher. The Socialization Cages Alcohol Panels and Alcohol Cassette Towers are proprietary to the Socialization Rack Caging Equipment.

3. Explain why the source is the only person or entity that can provide the required commodity:

Carter2 Systems is the sole manufacturer and supplier of the Socialization Cages Alcohol Panels and Alcohol Cassette Towers. They are not available from any other distributor. See supporting letter from Carter2 Systems, Inc, Attachment A.

4. Explain why the amount to be expended for the commodity is reasonable:

The estimated amount to be expended for the purchase of the Socialization Cages Alcohol Panels and Alcohol Cassette Towers is \$83,975.00. This amount is within the expected price range for these products.

5. Describe the efforts that the agency went through to obtain the best possible price for the commodity:

Through market intelligence, UMMC was able to negotiate best pricing for these products. All applicable discounts were explored and applied.
