The equipment should (i) allow for automated weighing of entire trains as they cross the scale at up to 10 km/hour (6 mph); (ii) obtain individual railcar weights without uncoupling of cars; (iii) calculate train total weights; (iv) obtain railcar identification information from an RFID tag and integrate such information into weighing record; (v) include a pc or equivalent controller with monitor; (vi) meet or exceed NIST HB-44 and OIML requirements; (vii) be certified to NTEP HB44 and other requirements to be used in legal-for-trade applications; (viii) allow for attended or unattended operation; (ix) provide adequate database storage and communication; and (x) allow for remote monitoring and system control.

The quoted price should include all manuals, drawings, warranties, etc., as well as costs to deliver and install the system and provide any necessary training.
