The Board of Aldermen and Mayor of the Town of Summit, Mississippi, will receive bids for the removal and replacement of concrete sidewalks along and adjacent to Robb Street for a total length of 0.081 miles, Federal Aid Urban Project No. STP-9618-00(001)LPA, FMS Project No. 107132-701000, no later than 10:00 A.M., Local Time, Tuesday, July 18, 2017, at the Town of Summit Board Room located at 706 East Railroad Avenue, Summit, MS 39666. All bids so received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work shall consist essentially of the following items:

Demolition and Replacement of existing sidewalks and other related items of work required to complete the project as shown and specified in the Contract Documents.

The above general outline of features of the work does not in any way limit the responsibility of the Contractor to perform all work and furnish all plant, labor, equipment and materials required by the specifications and the drawings referred to therein.

The attention of bidders is directed to the Contract Provisions governing selection and employment of labor. Minimum wage rates for Federal-Aid projects have been predetermined by the Secretary of Labor and are subject to Public Law 87-581 Work Hours Act of 1962, as set forth in the Contract Provisions.

The Board of Aldermen and Mayor of the Town of Summit, Mississippi hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged and women's business enterprises will be afforded the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The award of this contract will be contingent upon the Contractor satisfying the DBE/WBE requirements.

Plans and specifications are on file in the office of the Mississippi Department of Transportation.

A non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 is required at the time of request for Construction Drawings and Contract Documents. Plans will be shipped upon receipt of payment.

Bid bonds, signed or countersigned by a Mississippi Resident Agent, with Power of Attorney attached or on file with the Contract Administration Engineer of the Department, a Cashier's Check or Certified Check for five (5%) percent of bid, payable to the TOWN OF SUMMIT, MISSISSIPPI, must accompany each proposal. **NO STRIPPED PROPOSALS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

Bid preparation will be in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders bound in the Contract Documents. The Town of Summit, Mississippi reserves the right to waive any irregularities and to reject any or all bids.

The attention of bidders is directed to the provisions of Subsection 102.07 pertaining to irregular proposals and rejection of bids.

Work to be performed shall be in accordance with the "Mississippi State Highway Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", 2004 Edition, together with all amendments and/or special provisions and/or addenda to the standards duly approved and adopted, unless otherwise noted in these specifications.
