

**GOVERNMENT STREET IMPROVEMENTS AND PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Ocean Springs, until 2:00 P.M. local time, on February 18, 2016, and then said bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at Ocean Springs City Hall, Ocean Springs, Mississippi. Envelopes containing the Bids must be sealed, addressed to City Clerk, 1018 Porter Ave., Ocean Springs, Mississippi 39564.

The work shall consist of the following:

Project will consist of removal of 1797 square yards of existing concrete paved sidewalk, installation of 3355 square yards of new concrete paved sidewalk, installation of 244 square yards of treated timber boardwalk, installation of 200 square yards of prefabricated steel truss pedestrian bridge and includes all grading, excavation, fill, retaining wall, striping, signage and other incidentals.

The attention of bidders is directed to the Special Provisions governing selection and employment of labor. Minimum wage rates have been predetermined by the Secretary of Labor and are subject to Public Law 87-58 1, Work Hours Act of 1962, as set forth in the Contract Provisions.

The City of Ocean Springs hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex, age, disability, religion or national origin in consideration for an award.

The award of this contract will be contingent upon the Contractor satisfying the DBE/WBE requirements.

Bid bond, signed or countersigned by a Mississippi Agent or Qualified Nonresident Agent, with Power of Attorney attached, a Cashier's check or Certified Check for five (5%) percent of bid, payable to the CITY OF OCEAN SPRINGS, must accompany each proposal.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a contract bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount. Contract bond must be signed or countersigned by a Mississippi Agent or Qualified Nonresident Agent, with Power of Attorney.
