

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Separate and sealed bids for the construction of Corinth Utility Commission Altitude Valve Arrangements (ARC MS-17769-1) will be received by the Corinth Utilities Commission, at the Clifford G. Worsham Surface Water Treatment Facility, 2710 US Hwy 72 E Glen, MS 38846, until 10:00 AM on Monday, September 14th, 2015 and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The work consists of installing above ground Altitude Valve Arrangements, varying in main line sizes from 8" to 12", at five elevated tank sites. The arrangements will include Fiberglass Reinforced Polymer enclosures with concrete foundations, SCADA System upgrades, field piping and miscellaneous electrical.

Bids will be accepted only under the name of the Bidder to whom contract documents have been issued by the Engineer.

Each bidder must deposit with this bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

No Bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Simultaneously with his delivery of the executed contract, the Contractor shall furnish surety bonds subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

All applicable laws, ordinances and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the project shall apply to the contract throughout.

Each Bidder is responsible for inspecting the site and for reading and being thoroughly familiar with the Contract Documents. The failure or omission of any Bidder to do any of the foregoing shall in no way relieve any Bidder from any obligation in respect to this Bid.
