Scope of Work: Construct a new 2,200 gpm sewer pump station, 7,300 LF of 16" PVC force main, gravity sewer mains and other associated work in the northern parts of D'Iberville and Biloxi.

Effective July 1, 2010; Per MS Code 31-3-21(3); any bid submitted by a nonresident contractor which does not include the nonresident contractor's current state law pertaining to such state's treatment of nonresident contractors, shall be rejected and not considered for award. If no such law exists in the non-resident contractor's state, then the non-resident contractor may provide a statement to that effect.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
